Repatriation from Australia usually takes about 5 working days, from time of release from the coroner or hospital. This time frame can sometimes vary depending on government departments processing and issuing of paperwork, and flight availability, but most of our cases go ahead without any delays.

## Australian repatriation timeline:

- Family provides death certificate information and authorise authority to release
- Coroners or hospital release
- Coroner or Hospital issue the medical death certificate paperwork
- Issuing of non-infection letter
- Death Certificate registration
- Collection of Death Certificate from Registry
- Collection passport from local police authority
- Embalming
- Embalming certificate
- · Public notary if required
- Apostille if required
- Health Department clearance
- Consulate visit with original documents repatriation paperwork
- Authorisation of transport issued by Consulate
- · Coffin sealing and packaging
- Department of Foreign Affairs and Agriculture clearance
- Flights confirmation
- Delivery to airport
- Departure to destination
