# Sector leaders wanted to turn commitment into action.

- Structures that frontline staff and leaders could own together.







## Where Connect2Knowledge Came In

We designed and facilitated a sector-wide co-design journey that:

- ✓ Centred lived and living expertise
- ✓ Engaged frontline staff and over 75 sector leaders
- √ Translated complexity into clear, actionable solutions







#### From Ideas to Action

Grounded in trust and clarity, the process unfolded in four deliberate phases:

Early engagement with lived experts

Sector-wide environmental scan

Iterative co-design sessions with staff and leaders

Consolidation into three actionable solution areas

Strengthened sector partnerships and longterm alignment

A replicable, equity-centred model for future challenges







### Turning Collaboration Into Lasting Change

- ✓ Lived-experience journey maps that revealed "moments that matter"
- Actionable solutions co-designed and piloted by the sector
- ✓ Stronger alignment between Alliance and OSHN for long-term work
- A co-design model the sector now owns and can repeat
