## **Course Description**

*Exploring World Geography* from Notgrass History is a one-year high school course that describes and explains the world God created. Students will learn about mankind's interaction with the world both in the past and in the present. How have people made a difference in the physical world, and how are they making a difference in it today?

Your high school student will gain a rich understanding of physical and human geography through reading the narrative lessons, studying the maps and completing map assignments, learning about people and places around the world, completing assignments and hands-on projects, and gaining a Biblical perspective on world religions and culture.
