COMMUNITY BUILDING GRANTS

THE COMMUNITY BUILDING GRANTS PROGRAM AWARDS FUNDS TWICE ANNUALLY TO NONPROFITS WITH THE DEADLINES OF APRIL 1ST (FORMERLY FEB 1) AND OCTOBER 1ST. THE TYPICAL RANGE OF AWARDS IS \$5,000 TO \$30,000. HOWEVER, ANY REQUESTS OUTSIDE OF THAT RANGE CAN BE DISCUSSED WITH OUR OFFICE PRIOR TO SUBMITTAL.

CAPITAL PROJECT REQUESTS REQUIRE A SITE VISIT AND ALL PROJECTS REQUIRE A LETTER OF INTENT THAT NEEDS TO BE APPROVED BY FOUNDATION BEFORE PROCEEDING TO GRANT APPLICATION.

AFTER SCHOOL GRANTS

ALL K-8 SCHOOLS IN GRAYS HARBOR COUNTY THAT OFFER AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR AFTER SCHOOL FUNDING ONCE ANNUALLY. NONPROFITS THAT PROVIDE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING ARE ALSO ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR FUNDS.

***** ALL GRAYS HARBOR NONPROFITS AND SCHOOLS ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR EACH OF THESE OPPORTUNITIES ONCE ANNUALLY.**

IMPACT GRANTS

TO BE TRULY BE RESPONSIVE AND MEET THE NEEDS OF OUR COMMUNITY, GHCF OFFERS A QUARTERLY IMPACT GRANTS PROGRAM. THIS PROGRAM TARGETS ORGANIZATIONS LOOKING TO MAKE A MORE IMMEDIATE IMPACT ON A SMALLER SCALE. QUARTERLY IMPACT GRANTS WILL BE OFFERED THROUGH MULTIPLE GRANTING OPPORTUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR. FOR PROJECTS UP TO \$5,000.

EARLY LEARNING GRANTS

THE PROCESS

LOI

(JUST FOR COMMUNITY BUILDING GRANTS)- ALL INTERESTED ORGANIZATIONS MUST SUBMIT A LETTER OF INTENT ON OUR WEBSITE WITH A SHORT DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED PROJECT. ALL LOI'S MUST BE APPROVED BEFORE PROCEEDING TO THE APPLICATION STAGE,

REVIEW PERIOD


WE DO NOT REVIEW APPLICATIONS UNTIL AFTER THE DEADLINE AND WILL BE IN TOUCH WITH OUR DECISION WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DUE DATE.

APPLICATION

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE 5PM ON THE DUE DATE- NO EXCEPTIONS. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST HAVE DETAILED PROJECT BUDGET INFORMATION AS WELL AS QUOTES AND BIDS PROVIDED UPON SUBMITTAL.

FINAL REPORTING

AFTER A GRANT IS AWARDED AND WE HAVE RECEIVED A SIGNED AGREEMENT, YOU WILL HAVE 6 MONTHS TO REPORT BACK TO US ON THE STATUS OF YOUR PROJECT. FAULIRE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN INELIGIBILITY FOR FUTURE GRANT OPPORTUNITIES.
