### Address

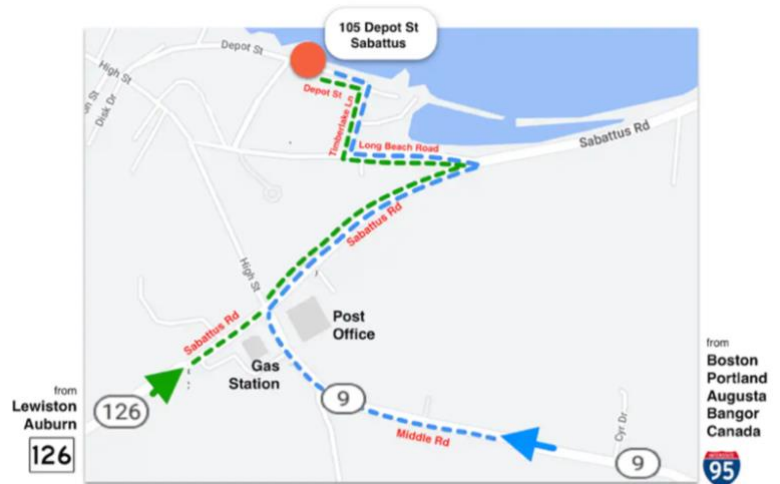
**105 Depot St, Sabattus, Maine 04280.**

## CHECKING IN

- We will send you WIFI and lock combo in a separate message day before arrival.
- **Check in is at 5pm.** Would be great if you let us know when you are planning to arrive.
- Please send us a message when you arrive so we know you've gotten in safely.

## CHECKING OUT

- Checkout is at **12:00 PM (noon)**.
- Before you leave, please:
  1. Turn off anything you turned on
  2. Return any furniture you moved to its original place
  3. Strip the beds you used
  4. Log out of any streaming services
  5. Let us know you are leaving.

## GOOD TO KNOW

- **Parking:** Park in the driveway, which fits up to 3 cars. The garage is not available for parking at this time.
- **Neighborhood:** The area is very safe and quiet. We share a private road with two other families.
- **Firewood:** Included. Let us know if you need more.
- **Games & lounge chairs:** Located in the garage.
- **Grill:** Gas is included. Let us know if it's running low.
- **Boat:** Included. Oars are in the garage, life jackets are in the round bin in the backyard, and fuel is in the garage. Please use only the fuel provided. Contact us if you'd like help getting set up.
- **Trash:** Bins are to the left of the garage and are emptied on Thursdays. Please make sure they're accessible to the collector. All trash and recycling should be bagged (bags are provided; any bags work).
- **Compost:** The stainless steel can is on the counter. The bin (metal, with holes) is next to the garbage.
- **Fishing:** Maine requires a fishing license. It's inexpensive and can be purchased online.
- **Foraging:** No license is required for mushroom foraging.

## EMERGENCIES

We're in a rural area, so power outages occasionally happen (though rarely). We have a generator we can help you set up. If the power goes out, please call us right away.

There are mosquitoes, flies, and occasional poison ivy in the area. Anti-mosquito spray is provided. If you're exposed to poison ivy, wash the affected area with cold water and soap.

In case of emergency, we use **St. Mary's Hospital** in Portland. For minor issues, we use **Maine Urgent Care**. For pet care, we use **Freeport Urgent Pet Care**.
