Restricted items, including those deemed prohibited and dangerous goods, are listed below. This list is general and provided as a guide only. Please review each carrier's own restricted items list at the links provided for further information on prohibited and dangerous goods, as well as exemptions and conditions of carriage.

Prohibited and Dangerous Goods:

- Ammunition & weapons
- Banknotes & coins
- Bleaches & poisons
- Batteries & corrosives
- Combustion engines
- Compressed gas
- Corrosives (Class 8)
- Dangerous Goods and Items
- Explosives & fireworks (Class 1)
- Flammable liquids (Class 3) & Flammable solids (Class 4)
- Gases (including aerosols) (Class 2)
- IATA listed items
- Illegal items
- Inadequately packaged & fragile items
- Live organisms & animals
- Matches
- Oxidising substances & organic peroxides (Class 5)
- Physically offensive items
- Radioactive materials (Class 7)
- Samples
- Toxic & infectious substances (Class 6)
- Unsolicited indecent or offensive material
- Valuable items
