Please review the accepted item lists and follow material preparation instructions.
All materials must be empty, clean, and dry.

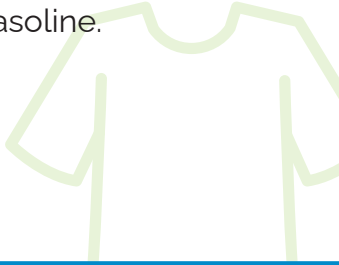
Textiles

Accepted:

Clothing, shoes, bedding, & fabric scraps.

Unaccepted:

Items that are wet, mildewed, or contain hazardous materials like oil or gasoline.



Light Bulbs

Accepted:

- Used and spent light bulbs
- Incandescent
- Halogen
- CFL
- LED

Unaccepted:

- Florescent
- Broken light bulbs



Plastic Clamshells

Accepted:

(PET or PETE ONLY)

Unaccepted:

Food soiled or wet clamshells, must be clean and dry. No RPET.

(Place in the provided trash bag)



Styrofoam

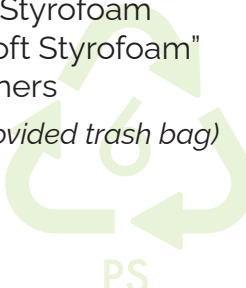
Accepted:

White block expanded polystyrene, #6.

Unaccepted:

- Small broken pieces
- Packing peanuts
- Wet or dirty Styrofoam
- Urethane "soft Styrofoam"
- Food containers

(Place in the provided trash bag)



Cork

Accepted:

Bottle corks made from 100% cork

Unaccepted:

Corks made from materials other than 100% cork such as wood, plastic, synthetic, or Diam.



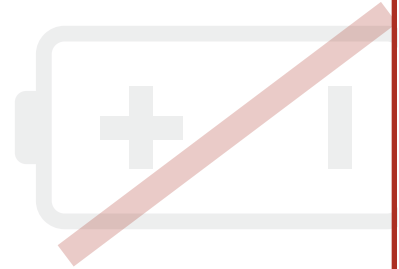

WE NO LONGER ACCEPT BATTERIES IN OFFICE FOR DROP OFF DUE TO FIRE RISK.














Batteries can be accepted at many Central Oregon Retailers. Contact Staples, Batteries and Bulbs, Lowes and Home Depot for more information.

Unaccepted:

- Frozen food bags
- Candy wrappers

- Degradable/compostable bags or film packaging
- Pre-washed salad mix bags
- Pet food bags
- Hot dog or meat wrap packaging
- Six-pack rings
- PPE - Gloves, mask, or protective wear
- Lamination film
- Silage and hay bags
- Backyard ice rinks
- Vinyl shower curtains or tablecloths
- Bedding or linen packaging
