Please review the accepted item lists and follow material preparation instructions.

All materials must be empty, clean, and dry.

Textiles

Accepted:

Clothing, shoes, bedding, & fabric scraps.

Unaccepted:

Items that are wet, mildewed, or contain hazardous materials like oil or gasoline.



Light Bulbs

Accepted:

- Used and spent light bulbs
- Incandescent
- Halogen
- CFL
- LED

Unaccepted:

- Fluorescent
- Broken light bulbs



Plastic Clamshells

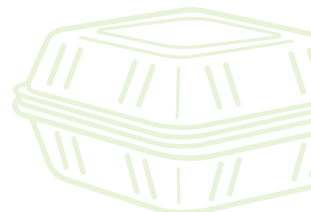
Accepted:

(PET or PETE ONLY)

Unaccepted:

Food soiled or wet clamshells, must be clean and dry. No RPET.

(Place in the provided trash bag)



Styrofoam

Accepted:

White block expanded polystyrene, #6.

Unaccepted:

- Small broken pieces
- Packing peanuts
- Wet or dirty Styrofoam
- Urethane "soft Styrofoam"
- Food containers

(Place in the provided trash bag)



Cork

Accepted:

Bottle corks made from 100% cork

Unaccepted:

Corks made from materials other than 100% cork such as wood, plastic, synthetic, or

Batteries

Accepted:

Single-use and rechargeable household batteries, A's, C's, D's, & 9V, & button batteries.

Unaccepted:

Car batteries and batteries over 11lbs.

The following batteries require tape:

- ☑ Tape (+) terminal
- ☑ Do not cover chemistry label
- ☑ Place rechargeable batteries such as cell phone or battery packs in a plastic bag.
- Lithium Batteries
- Button/Coin Cell
- Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb)
- Rechargeable greater than 9V
- (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, & Ni-Zn)
- Alkaline & Carbon Zinc greater than 12

Accepted Tape:

- Clear Packing tape
- Electrical tape
- Duct tape



Unaccepted Tape:

- Masking tape
- Painter's tape
- Scotch tape



NOTE: Batteries are accepted through RecyclePlus collection only—not as drop-offs at Cascade Disposal.

- Frozen food bags
- Candy wrappers
- Mulch or soil bags
- Chip bags
- Net or mesh produce Bags
- Degradable/compostable bags or film packaging
- Pre-washed salad mix bags
- Pet food bags
- Hot dog or meat wrap packaging
- Six-pack rings
- PPE - Gloves, mask, or protective wear
- Lamination film
- Silage and hay bags
- Backyard ice rinks
- Vinyl shower curtains or tablecloths
- Bedding or linen packaging
