All grades of standard fuel are available, making it a one-stop destination for both electric and combustion engine vehicle drivers.

Looking ahead, Høidahl added, "we are also excited to further expand our EV charging network in Sweden later this spring in Gårda, where we will open the first Circle K location to be exclusively dedicated to electric vehicle charging."
