As licensure recognition is ongoing in our region it requires continuous support and safeguarding as new legislature targeting the industry and its services often arise by those who do not yet fully understand our role in the built environment.

#### General

- Anywhere that IIDA is referenced in this Benefactor Packet, it is describing the local Chapter of IIDA which includes

  international IIDA organization, but the Benefactor monies and benefits are applied directly to the IIDA PA/NJ/DE
  Chapter. Money paid for individual or corporate memberships go to IIDA HQ in Chicago and NOT to individual
  Chapter(s).
- When submitting your company logo for use on web and print communications, be sure and submit a HI-RES JPEG or PNG file only. (DPI/PPI of 300 or higher)

#### **Events and Contingencies**

- All in-person events held by the IIDA PA NJ DE Chapter may change due to COVID-19 restrictions, regulations, other safety concerns, and unforeseen events outside of our control. These changes can include, but are not limited to a pivot from in-person to virtual, a reduction in event size or capacity, a relocation to an outdoor venue, a mask requirement / vaccination regulation, or event cancellation.
- IIDA has been and will continue to be creative in our event flexibility to provide the highest level of safety to our members and the industry. We are consistently following local regulations and commit to communicating any changes with our Benefactors. We appreciate your continued support and adaptability as we continue to work together to elevate the interior design industry!

#### **Non-Compete Clause and Benefactor Levels**

• To diversify our Industry Benefactors, we are enforcing a first-come, first-served non-compete clause for our Diamond Benefactor level. We believe this respects our Benefactors' interests, allows us to provide a variety of Benefactor content to our members and followers, and provides IIDA with the support it needs to implement our events and programs for our industry. General Benefactor quantity limitations (registration caps) will be enforced on a first come, first serve basis in the order that they are received.

We try our best to arrange events and Benefactor communication media to avoid competitive companies being located or displayed together but, in some instances, adjacencies are hard to avoid. Please be mindful that our Chapter Board as well as our events and programs are volunteer lead and run. Patience and respectful language when communicating with Board Members or event organizers /committee members is greatly appreciated.

#### **Event Definitions and Summaries**

VIDA Design Awards	Visionary Interior Design Awards. A Chapter-Wide event that accepts submissions from A&D Firms within Chapter Geography across a range of commercial project categories. Projects are reviewed by Design Professionals in other regions. Winners are announced at a Semi-Formal reception that includes food, drinks and networking. Rotates between city centers on an annual basis.
Elevate	Viewing the Documentary of the Student focused Day-Long Design Charrette.
Fashion Meets Finish	City Center specific. This event allows for creative collaboration between Designers & Manufacturers Reps. Committee paired teams create wearable fashion garments from commercial industry materials and present them during a runway fashion show. Rotates between city centers on an annual basis.
Product Parade	City Center specific. This event is part commercial product tradeshow and part industry party. Inspired by NeoCon, Product Parade connects users with the latest products and technologies within the Architecture and Design industry. Vendor participation includes product display booths*, food & bar stations, raffle prize opportunities and more.
Benefactor Spotlight	Company provided content posted on Chapter LinkedIn and Instagram. Content can include images, text (limit of 30 words) and short video content.
Instagram Takeover	Access to post image, video and other content onto Chapter Instagram Account for 24-hour period. Content subject to IIDA Chapter approval and code of conduct guidelines.
Logo Feature	Company logo included on Chapter Platforms and in Newsletter footer as freestanding image. Images are scaled according to size of media so reformatting with minor impacts to logo quality may occur. Images on website for top level benefactors will serve as hyperlinks to take visitors to manufacturer websites.
