#### **Getting Around**

- Free Mandalay Bay—Luxor— Excalibur Tram runs every few minutes and is fully air conditioned. No tickets or reservations are required.
- Indoor Walkway links the hotel lobby to the Convention Center—five minutes, zero desert heat.
- Rideshare Pick Up & Drop Off is signed "Uber | Lyft" at the Porte Cochère and South Beach garage level. Find it under "Uber" on the map <u>here</u>.
- Harry Reid International Airport is a 10 minute ride; rideshare beats taxi lines during the evening rush.

#### Layout at a Glance

Three primary levels in the South Convention Center.

- Level 1 Bayside Exhibit Halls & Food Court (Main Registration here). The Shark Reef Aquarium is just outside, and don't miss it!
- Level 2 Shoreline Exhibit Hall, Oceanside Ballroom & Keynote Hall (core briefings).
- Level 3 South Seas complex (smaller breakouts and quiet corners).

#### **Navigation Tips**

- **1. Hotel to Hall Route:** From the front desk, stay left and follow the cobblestone path; you'll reach Bayside in under five minutes without stepping outside.
- 2. Need to Move Fast? The complimentary tram beside the casino's south exit shuttles you to Luxor and Excalibur in minutes, handy for off site meetings.
- **3. Meeting Spots:** The Shoreline Prefunction (outside Oceanside Ballroom) has the strongest cell signal and plenty of seating for quick huddles.

#### **Amenities Worth Knowing**

- A dedicated rideshare lounge one level below the Bayside Exhibit Halls can save valuable time.
- Charging lounges, a full service business center, and a mothers' room on Level 1.
- Prayer room and quiet pods located near the Shoreline entrance on Level 2.

**Insider Tip:** Sessions in the Oceanside Ballroom empty directly into Shoreline Prefunction. Schedule meet-ups there to catch colleagues as they exit.

# **TLDR:** Tips for Making the Most of Black Hat 2025

#### Beat the Heat, Own the Day: 01

Vegas averages 100°F+ in August; use the indoor walkway and tram, carry a refillable bottle, and schedule outside meetings for early mornings or after sunset.

#### Plan A & Plan B Sessions:

Popular briefings lock out fast. In the Black Hat mobile app, star those you must attend and mark a backup talk in the same slot in case the room fills.



#### Work the Business Hall Strategically:

Block out two focused hours when it opens at 10 AM on Wednesday; vendors are fresh, swag piles are full, and you'll beat the afternoon rush.



#### **Network on Purpose:**

Post key takeaways on X/LinkedIn, tag speakers, and send quick "great to meet you" DMs before leaving the expo floor while faces remain fresh.



#### Land the Follow Up:

Set 15 minutes on your flight home to sort business cards into "act this week" and "nurture" piles; fire off calendar invites or LinkedIn voice notes within 48 hours.

Master these essentials and you'll leave Black Hat with a full notebook, a lighter badge lanyard, and a network that pays dividends long after the Locknote ends.

Want the insider's scoop? Read on for the full details of our best tips.

#### Tip #1: Prepare for Vegas Heat

- Early August highs hover around 104°F/40°C with single digit humidity. Hydrate constantly and stash a mini sunscreen in your badge pouch.
- Stick to Mandalay Bay's indoor walkway or the free tram for anything south of the casino; you can cross three resorts without touching the sidewalk.

#### Tip #2: Develop a Plan A, Plan B, and Plan C

Popular sessions cap out fast. Star your musts in the <u>Black Hat mobile app</u>, then mark two backups in the same slot so you're never left roaming the hallway. The same tactic saved us at RSAC and works here, too.



#### Tip #3: Work the Business Hall With Intent

- Block a 10:00 AM noon slot on Wednesday: vendors are fresh, swag piles are full, and you'll beat the post-lunch rush.
- SandboxAQ Booth #5721: swing by for the Saloon Showdown trivia game, limited-edition cyber western swag, and a 10-minute demo on quantum-ready crypto and AI-powered threat intel.

#### 04 Tip #4: Engage Actively

- Demo Arsenal tools hands-on, then tweet key takeaways with #BlackHatUSA while the speaker is still on stage. Tagging presenters could raise the visibility of your post.
- Keep a running Google Doc of sessions and contacts; use your flight home to bullet out next steps, then share the doc company-wide by Monday.



#### Tip #5: Land the Follow-Up

Send LinkedIn voice notes or calendar invites **within 48 hours**; your name stays top-of-mind long after the Locknote ends.
