A Note from Leadership

Dear Supporters, Partners, and Friends,

Each year brings new faces, new stories, and a renewed sense of purpose at Sorrentino's Compassion House. Over the past year, 291 women came through our doors. Together, they stayed with us 451 times, representing 4,101 nights of care, connection, and rest during treatment. Our shuttle van travelled 11,712 kilometers to ensure women could get to their appointments, safely and on time.

Numbers help show the scope of what happens here, but they only hint at the experience inside the House. Women arrive carrying uncertainty and leave with a sense of steadiness that comes from being surrounded by others who understand. Conversations in the kitchen, quiet moments of encouragement in the coffee room, and shared activities create a space where no one feels like a stranger for long.

The work we do is made possible by people who give their time, energy, and resources. Staff bring compassion and consistency to each day. Volunteers add warmth and care in countless ways, often behind the scenes. Donors make it all possible. As we do not receive government funding, we rely heavily on the generosity of individuals, businesses, and community partners who believe in what happens here. Because of that support, we are able to continue offering a safe, affordable home-away-from-home where women can focus on their healing.

In this House, no one faces cancer alone.

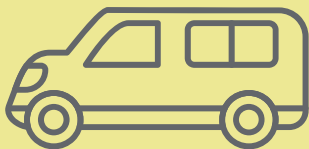

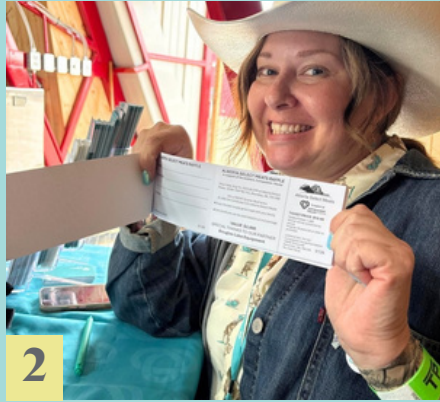

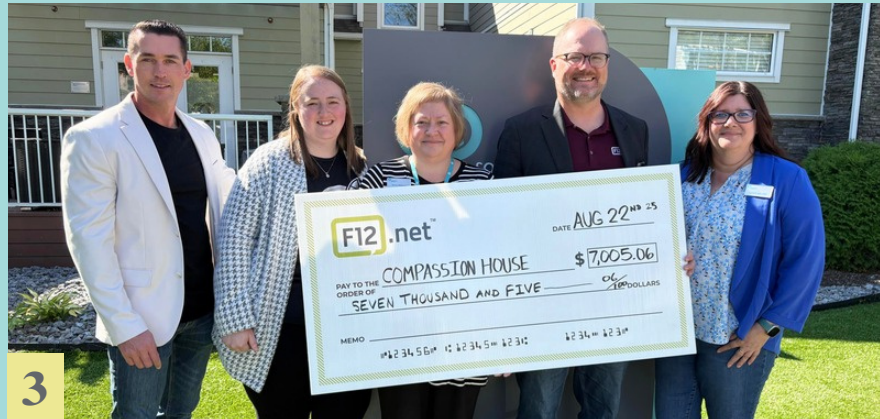
