


SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Word Count: 1,200 words (submissions significantly over or under may be edited or returned for revision)

Images & Graphics: Up to 3 images, graphics, charts, or infographics may be submitted alongside your article. All visuals should be submitted as high-resolution files (300 DPI minimum) in JPG or PNG format. Please include a brief caption for each image.

Author Headshot: A professional headshot is required. Please submit as a high-resolution JPG or PNG (300 DPI minimum).

Author Bio: Include a short bio of 75–100 words covering your current role, areas of expertise, and any relevant credentials or accomplishments. Please also include your name, title, company, and a contact email for our editorial team.

Formatting: Submit articles as a Microsoft Word document (.docx). Please use standard fonts (Arial or Times New Roman, 11 or 12pt), double-spaced. Do not submit PDFs for article text.

Original Content: All submissions must be original, previously unpublished work. Articles may not be simultaneously submitted to other publications.

Disclosure: Please disclose any potential conflicts of interest. Promotional or advertorial content will not be accepted as editorial submissions — advertising opportunities are available separately.

EDITORIAL GUIDELINES

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Articles should be informative, insightful, and written for a professional audience of government and industry leaders. First-person perspective is welcome. Avoid overly promotional language — the goal is to provide genuine value to our readers through expertise, experience, and ideas.

FORUM reserves the right to edit submissions for clarity, length, style, and fit. Authors will be notified of any significant edits prior to publication.

Deadline to submit article and all deliverables: April 17, 2026

IMPACT

Deadline to Confirm you will be sending an article: May 8, 2026

Deadline to submit article and all deliverables: June 26, 2026

FORUM Power

Deadline to Confirm you will be sending an article: September 4, 2026

Deadline to submit article and all deliverables: October 9, 2026

Late submissions cannot be guaranteed placement. We encourage submitting early.
