

## Minor Protection Standards – StudentSpace Dormitory

### Abbreviated version

#### 1. Safe relationships

- Contact between StudentSpace staff and persons conducting events on the premises of the Student Residence (Animators) with Minors is strictly professional in nature.
- StudentSpace staff may only enter a Minor's room after informing the Minor and the designated ICE contact in advance, at least by email.
- If it is necessary for StudentSpace staff to enter a Minor's room, this should be done in the presence of two members of staff and with the door open.

#### 2. Contact outside working hours

- Contact between Staff or Animators and Minors shall take place only during working hours and shall be limited to business matters.
- All correspondence should be conducted via work email addresses.
- Staff and Animators may not contact Minors through private communication channels.

#### 3. Visits by guests

- Visits by Minors are recorded in a visitor log, which may be viewed by the Minors' legal guardians.

#### 4. Procedure in emergency situations
