### May & June 2026 Activities

- Code Enforcement
  - Asked Justin for status of ordinance review
  - Getting Frank Nakamura's contract reviewed by Justin
  - Getting contract from Ross Mitchell, Salina code enforcement officer, for review
  - Goal to have everything ready by August 1
  - Would like to hold a public hearing or meeting in July to inform everyone that ordinance enforcement will be happening
  - At today's Rural Cacus meeting several towns asked to contact me about how Torrey is implementing code enforcement.
- Post Office
  - Bicknell post office officials asked for the status of Torrey acquiring more parcel boxes
  - I told them that I am working with a My Package Guy to set up a facility in Torrey that will include a contract post office.
  - Cathy sent my last response to her boss
  - It is time to engage with Congresswoman Malloy's staff to see if it is possible to get the post office leadership to help resolve the issues
  - Torrey can submit a request for a Needs Analysis to USPS
    - With Copilot's help I have drafted the document and will send it to all council members and staff
    - The document needs formatting tweaks and a review of the document
- Open Meeting Training
  - More in-depth Open and Public Meetings Act (OPMA) training is needed
  - Annual training is a requirement and the 10-minute course on the state auditor's website is insufficient
  - R6 offers free and extensive training
  - The consequences of violating OPMA can be significant
