August & September 2026 Activities

- Recognition of Patriots Day
 - September 11 marks twenty-five years since the attacks on our nation. We honor those lost, the first responders who served, and the veterans who have defended us since. Town flags will fly at half-staff through sunset in accordance with Presidential proclamation.
- The Torrey Operations Modernization Project
 - Created a draft documents organization plan
 - Thanks to Melinda for her help
 - Melinda is working on converting the backroom into workspace for clerk, treasurer, and anyone that needs a place to work
 - Creating a list of procedures to document everything that Torrey town must do
- Water
 - With Melinda and Dustin's help sorting out current ERU usage and commitments
 - Discussion with Kelly and Dustin about where the best location for is for a new well
- Attended Cybersecurity workshop
 - Water systems security was a significant portion of the workshop
 - All water systems in the state of Utah must create a Water System Cybersecurity Plan
 - Grants are available to fund the creation of the plan
 - SCADA systems have been compromised
 - 3 weeks ago, it was discovered that 14 SCADA systems in Utah were listed on a Dark Website that were accessible from the Internet
 - Torrey's SCADA must have a cybersecurity review
 - There are many resources available from the state and federal government agencies

- Code Enforcement
 - Title 12 Code Enforcement is ready for review and adoption
 - Drafted contracts for code enforcement official and hearing officer
 - Hearing officer, Frank Nakamura, will also be the appeals officer for P&Z appeals and variance requests
 - This is required by state law 10-99a-107
- Post Office
 - Submitted needs analysis to USPS
 - Need to get businesses and citizens to sign or provide letter of support
 - The letters of support will be submitted to USPS
 - Sent draft letter of support to Senator Curtis staffer for the Senator to sign and submit to USPS
- IT
 - Began email migration
 - Colleen's old all-in-one computer can be used as a monitor
 - The disk was wiped
