Tournament Rules

- This tournament is open to all current USBC members, in good standing. Members not sanctioned with Carson Country USBC may enter by paying the appropriate (national, state and/or local) membership dues.
- The entry fee for this tournament is \$60.00 per bowler \$120 per Team (lineage \$24.00, expenses \$6.00 & prize fund \$30.00 per bowler).**
Entry fees may be paid via cash, check, money order or Venmo (@ccusbcnv). Make checks payable to CCUSBC. Entrant is responsible for returned checks; a \$40.00 collection fee will be charged. If a check is returned, the entrant will be required to pay the entry fee and bank fees via cash prior to squad time or entry will be voided.

Preregistration for this tournament ends on March 19th, 2026.

Walk-in bowlers will be allowed to enter one hour prior to the start of the tournament/squad and are subject to \$5.00 late-entry fee.

- Averages will be accepted in the following order:**
 1. Composite Average for the 2024-25 season.
 2. Composite Average for the 2023-24 season.
 3. Current League Highest 25-26 sanctioned average of 21 games

Averages will be adjusted according to USBC rules for all PBA Leagues and Sport/Challenge Shot Leagues or ANY league that changes patterns for their league throughout the season.
- If the submitted average is lower than required and results in more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
- Handicap will be determined on a game basis, based on 90% of 240 and applied to each bowler.
- Entrants are required to check in no less than 30 minutes prior to squad time for lane assignments. Walk-ins must arrive 60 minutes prior to squad time. Any participant arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score will count beginning in the frame then being bowled. No score will be given for the frames missed.
- All prize money will be returned 100% on a ratio of 1 in 4 bowlers, or major portion thereof. Prize checks will be distributed within 30 days after the tournament closes (except when USBC has authorized delay in payment pending the settlement of any claim or protest that affects position standings).
- In the event of ties for cash prizes, money for the places tied will be divided accordingly.
- All bowlers will bowl two separate three-game blocks of Doubles, for a total of six games.**
- A maximum of two entries per bowler will be allowed.
- Substitutes will not be permitted.
- All recaps should be signed by the entrant. Each bowler is responsible for verifying that his or her scores have been written correctly as all recaps are official records of scores bowled. If recaps are not signed, scores will be accepted as read.
- Errors in scoring must be reported prior to the start of the next squad.
- Disputes involving pin fall, fouls, etc. must be referred to a Tournament Official in the frame in question. Bowlers will not make corrections to the scoring units or recap sheets without a Tournament Official's approval.
- Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager before the tournament prize payments are made. Recaps are official records of scores bowled.

16. Only bowlers and officials will be allowed in the playing area. No food or beverages will be allowed in the playing area.
17. Bowlers using loud or abusive language or conduct unbecoming of a bowler shall have one warning. If misconduct continues, bowler will be removed from the lanes. The bowler will forfeit any awards and prize money to that event.
18. Reasonable attire is required, and determination is at the discretion of the Tournament Management.
19. The tournament officials are empowered to remove a player for an infraction of USBC and/or CCUSBC rules and regulations that apply to this tournament.
20. Entries will be scheduled according to requests if possible and in the order received. The Tournament Manager, except for an emergency, will not change the schedule. The Tournament Manager will assign lanes for each event. Each event will be bowled on a single pair of lanes.
21. **Should a squad have 8 bowlers or less, the Tournament Manager reserves the right to not hold that squad. Bowlers will be advised and asked to pick another squad.**
22. The oil pattern will be the house shot that has been used for a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the start of the tournament.
23. All USBC Rules not mentioned will apply. Tournament Management shall decide any questions not covered by the rules. **The decision of Tournament Management will be final unless appealed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.**
