



**Carson Country USBC**

1. This tournament is open to adults who wish to support the youth. Entries are due by Wednesday, April 22, 2026.
2. This is a no-tap (9 pins on first ball counts as a strike) tournament. Four consecutive games shall be bowled and total pins, with handicap, shall decide the winner.
3. Entry fee will be \$30.00 for adults with lineage \$12.00, prize fund \$5, and youth scholarship fund, \$13.00. The entry fees may be paid by cash, check or Zeffy. Make checks payable to CCUSBC Youth. Any entries received after Wednesday will incur a \$5 late fee that will be added to the scholarship fund. Entrant is responsible for all returned checks; a \$40.00 collection fee will be charged. If a check is returned, the entrant will be required to pay the entry fee and bank fees via cash prior to squad time or entry will be voided.
4. This tournament will be handicapped at 100% of 240. Maximum score is 300. All sport averages will be converted to standard averages for the tournament. Entering averages will be determined as follows:
  - a. USBC members will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average.  
Averages will be determined in the following order:
    - i. Highest current winter average
    - ii. Highest summer league average of at least 21 games
    - iii. Most recent book average if not current bowler
  - b. Non-USBC member adults:
    - i. Females will enter at 150.
    - ii. Males will enter at 170.
5. Tournament will start at 1:30 pm. Entrants are required to checkin at least 30 minutes prior for lane assignments.
6. The prize fund will be awarded at a ratio of 1 in 10 with the youth scholarship funds being added to the Youth/Alumni prizes for distribution in SMART accounts.
7. Only bowlers and officials will be allowed in the playing area. No alcohol, tobacco, nor vaping is to be consumed on or behind the lanes during this tournament. No food or beverages will be allowed in the playing area. Only tournament officials will be allowed to correct scores.
8. Bowlers using loud or abusive language or conduct unbecoming of a bowler shall have one warning. If misconduct continues, bowler will be removed from the lanes. The bowler will forfeit any awards and money.
9. Reasonable attire is required, and determination is at the discretion of the Tournament Management.
10. The tournament officials are empowered to remove a player for an infraction of USBC and/or CCUSBC rules and regulations that apply to this tournament.
11. The oil pattern will be the house shot that has been used for a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the start of the tournament.
