

THE I.B.E.W. LOCAL 1249

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- ✓ Ten (10) scholarships with a stipend of \$3,000 per year will be awarded for up to four years on a competitive basis.
- ✓ Scholarships need to be renewed every year. (See Renewal Standards)

Winners of a Scholarship may attend any accredited post-secondary college, university, or vocational school in the United States and may select any course of study leading to a degree. Both choices should be guided by the student's evaluation of his or her interests, needs and abilities.

QUALIFICATIONS

To qualify for the competition, the applicant must:

- Have a parent who has been an Active Participant in the I.B.E.W. Local 1249 Insurance Fund for the last five years.
- Be a high school senior who will graduate in June of 2026, or a high school graduate within the last two years (or for graduate school, be a college senior, or college graduate within the last three years), and who will attend any accredited post-secondary college, university, or vocational school in the United States in the Fall of 2026 on a full-time basis (generally, at least 12 credit hours per semester).

HOW TO APPLY

To be considered for an I.B.E.W. Local 1249 Scholarship, you must:

- Fill out and return the application form with a 100-150 word essay explaining why you deserve this scholarship, including the need for financial assistance.
- Submit copies of all academic transcripts from high school, college or other educational and development programs.
- Submit proof of acceptance/enrollment, if available, to the school you will be attending.

- Your scholarship application must be received by June 1, 2026.

HOW WINNERS ARE DETERMINED

Each candidate is reviewed by the scholarship committee and then scholarships are awarded for qualified candidates according to random selection.

Winners will be announced in/around July of 2026. Each scholarship award will become effective when the winner is enrolled in the school to which he/she has been admitted. All levels and amounts are at the discretion of the Program and are subject to change.

A scholarship winner who maintains satisfactory progress toward his/her degree according to standards for scholarship renewal set by the scholarship committee may be able to retain his/her scholarship throughout the four-year term (or shorter time frame depending on the nature of the school). **Please note that there is no guarantee that a scholarship will be renewed and, regardless of progress, it is possible that a scholarship may not renew.**

It is mandatory that the student qualify each year by furnishing the Scholarship Committee with evidence of satisfactory academic progress. If a recipient's studies are interrupted by illness, accident, or some other extenuating circumstance, the student may request that his/her I.B.E.W. Local 1249 Scholarship be held during that time. Any such interruption must be reported promptly to the Scholarship Committee for action.

RENEWAL STANDARDS

You are to furnish the Scholarship Committee with an annual report listing the courses that you have or will take and the grades received in each academic period. The report should be verified by the appropriate official at the school and mailed to the Scholarship Committee at I.B.E.W. Local 1249 (Scholarship Program), 8531 Brewerton Road, Suite 1, Cicero, NY 13039. In addition, you must maintain full-time student status and a 2.0 grade point average.
