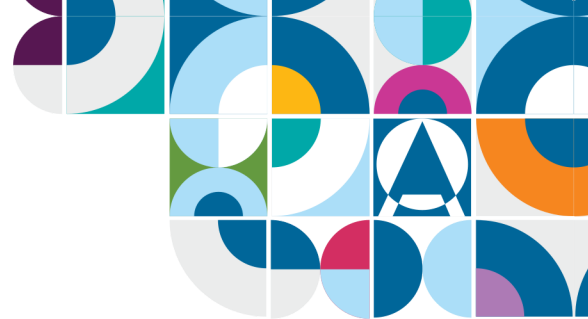




Billing and Payment Information for Patients

SAAmplify-αSYN provides the clarity you need to move forward with confidence.

Your doctor has prescribed the **SAAmplify-αSYN™ test**, the breakthrough tool used to define neuronal synuclein disease in the Parkinson's Precision Medicine Initiative (PPMI) clinical study involving over 5000 participants. It is the **only diagnostic test for misfolded, pathologic synuclein validated against the 'gold standard' of autopsy findings.**

In 2023, the Michael J. Fox Foundation announced a **breakthrough** facilitated by the **Amprion SAAmplify-αSYN test**, saying it *"heralds the revolutionary ability for research to define Parkinson's disease biologically, offering a critical tool for clinical trial design and assessment of treatment effects, and for **early detection of disease pathology.**"*

Amprion is committed to ensuring every patient can access the SAAmplify-αSYN test.

We work with each patient and their plan to **maximize benefits and minimize out-of-pocket costs** whenever possible. Our Patient Support Team helps you navigate insurance and explore all available payment options, so you have complete financial peace of mind when accessing this innovative test.

We aim for **total transparency**. Amprion provides a clear billing policy and discloses our affordable self-pay pricing up front for everyone, ensuring no one is left without a path forward if insurance coverage is unavailable. Our robust financial assistance program is designed to meet you where you are. For qualifying households, **out-of-pocket costs can be as low as \$100**, and we offer six-month, interest-free payment plans to keep your care manageable.

MEDICARE

Amprion is a **Medicare participating provider**. Medicare hasn't yet issued a coverage decision, so you must complete, sign, and date a Medicare ABN (form CMS-R-131) that instructs Amprion how to proceed with billing. The ABN is a tool for your protection that provides total clarity on coverage, giving you the power to make an informed choice about your care with no financial surprises. Your doctor will send the ABN to Amprion with your specimen. There are multiple options on the form to choose:

- If you choose **Option 1**, a **claim will be sent to Medicare** at the test list price. If Medicare denies the claim, you may be invoiced for the denied charges. If this happens, Amprion's Patient Support Team can assist you in finding the best payment option to minimize your out-of-pocket costs whenever possible.
- If you choose **Option 2**, you may self-pay, and **Amprion will invoice you at a discounted price** (see self-pay option below). In this case, an insurance claim will not be submitted to Medicare.

MEDICAID

Although Amprion is not yet a Medicaid participating provider, we are dedicated to universal access through a transparent billing policy. For those with Medicaid, we offer affordable self-pay pricing and sliding-scale assistance that can reduce **out-of-pocket costs to as little as \$100 for qualifying households.**

AMPRION

PRIVATE INSURANCE AND TRICARE

Amprion will bill your primary insurance at your request:

- Please complete a Patient Consent Form.
- Please provide your complete insurance information to enable us to submit a claim (at the test list price).*
- As for all medical costs, you are responsible for fulfilling your copay, coinsurance, deductible, and remaining non-covered costs, as well as forwarding any direct payments you receive to Amprion.
- You may elect the self-pay option if you have high deductibles or believe your plan will not reimburse for the test.

SELF-PAY

- If you are not insured or choose not to have a claim submitted to your insurance, Medicare, or Medicaid, **you may self-pay at a special discounted price of \$995.†** An additional **prompt-pay discount of \$200** is available if you remit payment of \$795 to Amprion within 15 days of the initial bill date.
- No claim will be submitted to insurance, Medicare, or Medicaid.

AMPRION PAYMENT AND FINANCIAL PROGRAMS‡

- Amprion offers a robust billing and financial assistance program to help reduce your out-of-pocket costs whenever possible.
- A six-month, interest-free payment plan is available to help you pay for this test.
- **You may qualify for financial assistance** before, during, or after testing is complete or after insurance has processed a claim (see chart below). You may request a good-faith estimate of your financial responsibility for the SAAmplify-αSYN test. Final determination cannot be made until we receive your completed Amprion Financial Assistance application and the required supporting documentation, so it's important to send these items as soon as you can.
