Participation can include:

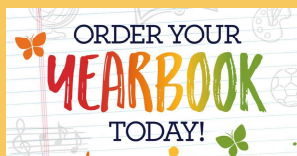
- Giving a short presentation about your career

Yearbooks are \$30.00 and will be sold online using the QR Code provided. Once books arrive we can not guarantee that there will be any sold. It is best to pre-order.



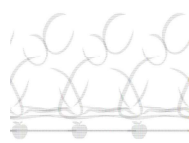

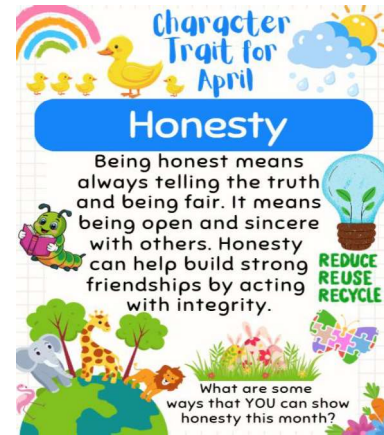
Vision Statement
