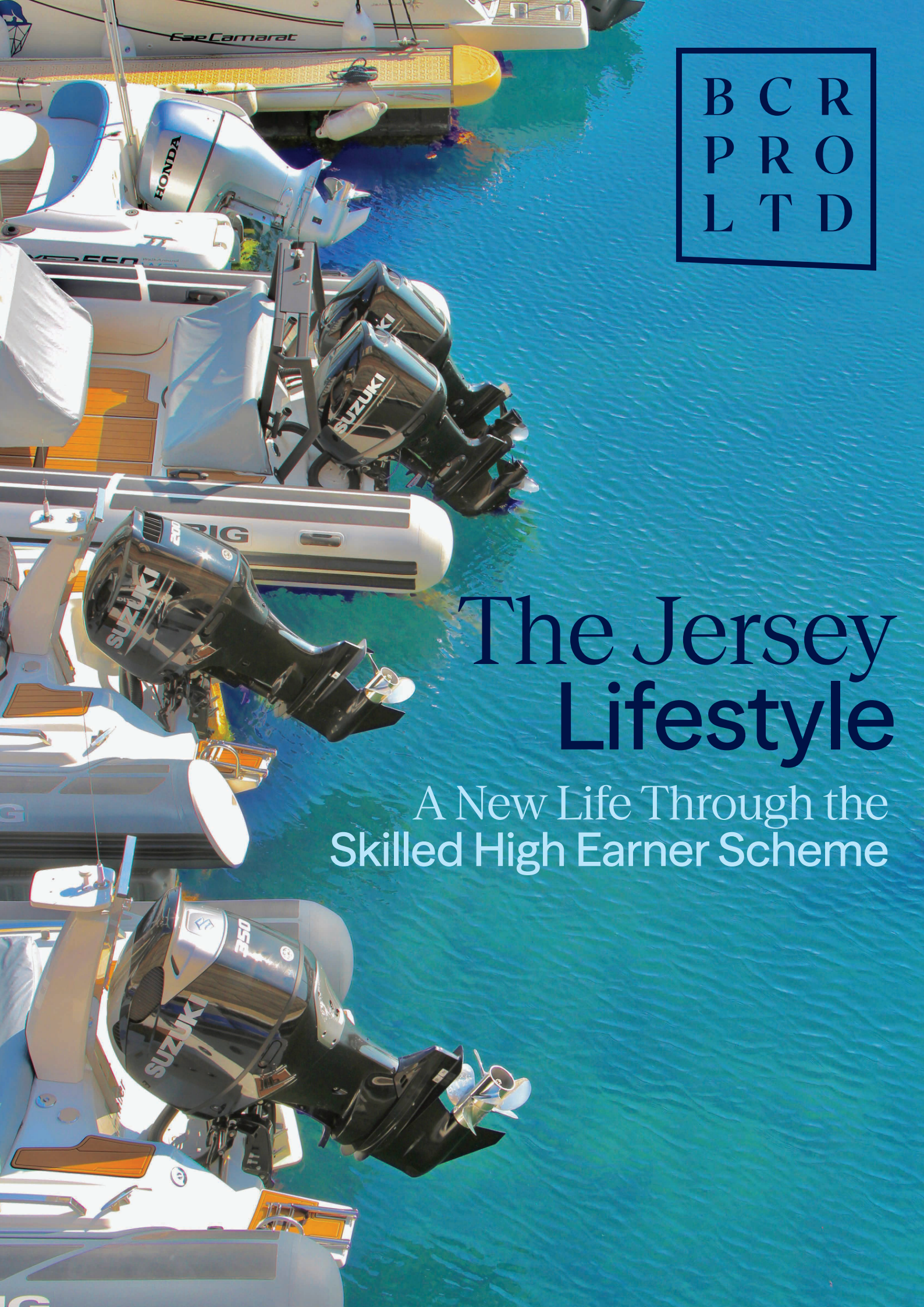

- No VAT (Jersey operates a 5% Goods and Services Tax (GST) instead).

The route is designed for individuals who are not currently resident in Jersey and wish to:

- Relocate to the Island.
- Establish a business in Jersey.
- Take an active, full-time role within that business.

Applicants are expected to work more than 25 hours per week and generate genuine earned income from their business activity.

Fincancial & Economic Requirements

Applicants must demonstrate the ability to earn at least £250,000 per year, taxable in Jersey, with evidence showing this income can be maintained until they achieve Entitled status or for up to ten years.

There is also a housing requirement to buy or rent a property with a value of £2million plus.

Successful applicants are also expected to make a positive contribution to Jersey's economy through investment, business leadership, mentoring or wider community involvement.

The Application Process

Applications are considered by the States of Jersey and include a detailed assessment of:

- Your professional background and experience.
- Your financial position.
- Your business plans and projected income.

A well-prepared application supported by robust financial information and a clear commercial strategy is essential to maximise the prospects of approval.
