



7.0 UPRIGHT MONUMENT REGULATIONS

7.1 The Cemetery reserves the right to initiate enforcement of its rules and regulations at any time and to remove any adornment that is unsafe, inappropriate or offensive.

7.2 Temporary Markers used in the Upright Monument Sections shall be no larger than 6" x 12" x 3/4" with stake no longer than 12" in length, and contain the name, year of birth and death of the deceased. All approved temporary markers are allowed for a period of six months from the date of interment. The Cemetery recommends that all temporary markers include the grave location for identification purposes.

7.3 If an approved adornment is placed in the one foot area in front of the monument, the responsible party agrees to maintain the area. If in event the area becomes unsightly the Cemetery reserves the right to remove all adornments.

7.4 No more than (6) six adornments or objects will be permitted per grave.

7.5 Fences, enclosures, banners, shepherd's hooks, headstone saddle/pillow decoration, windchimes, pinwheels, stones of any type, or glass items are not permitted in any section of the Cemetery.

7.6 Balloons will not be permitted anywhere in the Cemetery.

7.7 Plantings and adornments which do not exceed 18" in height placed within one foot of the base of the monument or foundation shall be permitted. If the Responsible Party places an approved adornment in the one foot area in front of the monument, they agree to maintain the area. The Cemetery shall not be responsible for damage done by any person to the plantings and adornments. The Cemetery shall not be responsible to maintain or preserve the planting. If the plantings are not maintained, overgrown, or are unsightly, the Cemetery shall remove the planting or adornments.

7.8 Flags are permitted only at the head of interment spaces and can be no higher than two feet. All flags placed in an Armed Forces or First Responder flag holder must comply with the maximum height of the monument permitted in the section. Permitted flags are limited to U.S. flags, flags of Armed Forces branch of the United States Military, POW/MIA flags, and flags representing the decedent's country of origin.

7.9 Only plastic vigil lights shall be permitted. The Cemetery shall not be responsible for damage to or removal of vigil lights.

7.10 Exceptions to the foregoing regulations are as follows:

Palm Sunday: Palms are permitted.

Christmas: Christmas blankets are permitted.

7.11 Flowers may be placed on the interment space in conjunction with the funeral service and will be removed the same day of the service.
