This Privacy Policy explains how Solarte Piotr Rogacki ("we", "us", or "our") collects, uses, discloses, and protects your personal information when you use our website (<https://www.solarte.tech>) or engage with us through sales, marketing, or events.

1. What Information Do We Collect?

Personal information you provide to us:

We collect personal details you choose to share with us, such as: - Name - Phone number - Email address

We do not process sensitive personal data (e.g. racial or ethnic origin, religious beliefs, sexual orientation).

Information we collect automatically:

This includes IP address, browser and device characteristics, referring URLs, location data, and technical data like crash reports and system settings. We also collect cookie-based data (see Cookie Notice).

2. How Do We Process Your Information?

We use your information to: - Provide, improve, and manage our Services - Communicate with you - Ensure security and prevent fraud - Comply with legal obligations

We may also process data to protect someone's vital interests (e.g. prevent harm).

3. What Legal Bases Do We Rely On?

We process your personal data based on: - **Consent** (which can be withdrawn at any time) - **Legal obligations** (e.g. responding to authorities or fulfilling tax laws) - **Vital interests** (e.g. in emergencies)

Special provisions apply if you're located in the EU, UK, or Canada.

4. When and With Whom Do We Share Your Information?

We may share data: - In connection with business transfers (e.g. merger or acquisition)

5. Do We Use Cookies and Tracking Technologies?

Yes. We use cookies, web beacons, pixels, and third-party tracking (e.g. Google Analytics) to: - Understand site usage - Improve Services - Personalise content and ads

6. How Long Do We Keep Your Data?

We retain data only as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes in this notice, or as required by law (e.g. tax or legal compliance). When no longer needed, data is deleted or anonymised.

7. How Do We Keep Your Data Safe?

We apply technical and organisational measures to safeguard data. However, no online transmission is 100% secure. Access our Services at your own risk, within a secure environment.

8. Do We Collect Data From Minors?

No. We do not knowingly collect or market to anyone under 18 years old.

9. Your Privacy Rights

Depending on your location, you may have rights to: - Access, correct, or delete your data - Withdraw consent - File a complaint with a data authority

EEA, UK, Switzerland, and Canada residents have enhanced rights under local laws.

10. Do-Not-Track Controls

We currently do not respond to DNT signals, due to lack of a standard method for enforcement.
