

## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- HIFEM procedure enhanced the sexual function of all (N=15) treated women.
- PISQ-12 score showed **significant** improvement by **5.8 points** (+19%; P<0.001).
- The greatest change was observed in partner-related domain (+3.3 points, P<0.001).
- Subjects reported more intense and frequent orgasm along with greater sexual desire and excitement.
- The subjects with lower PISQ scores at the baseline benefited most from the treatment.



Mean PISQ-12 score before and after the treatments divided according to the domains. Improvement was found to be statistically significant in each domain (P<0.05).
