## **What is the mission you are most proud of?**

I'd say the implementation of the 802.1x feature. It was a very technical topic, and quite unclear to me at first since I don't have a network administration background. But step by step, I managed to understand how everything worked and to build a solid solution. It was a real challenge and a great personal achievement.

Don't stress if everything feels a bit unclear at first. The projects are technical, but everyone has been there, and the team is always happy to help. By asking questions and taking things step by step, you'll quickly feel comfortable. The atmosphere is simple and genuinely supportive.
