Urbanest, Darling Square

Urbanest | Darling Harbour, NSW | \$140m

The Urbanest Darling Harbour Student Accommodation development delivered Australia's first fully catered high-rise student accommodation precinct, providing 1,300 beds across two residential towers within Sydney's Darling Harbour precinct. Johnstaff provided end-to-end Project Management services from project initiation through to commissioning and handover, including management of critical development and transport authority agreements. The project required complex stakeholder coordination, interface management and early contractor involvement to address significant site constraints and programme requirements. Our team successfully managed approvals, procurement and risk, enabling delivery within budget and in line with academic occupancy deadlines.

Seventh Day Adventist Church | Wahroonga, NSW | \$90m

The Quarters delivered 186 student and key worker apartments, providing modern on-site accommodation and supporting workforce needs across the hospital campus. 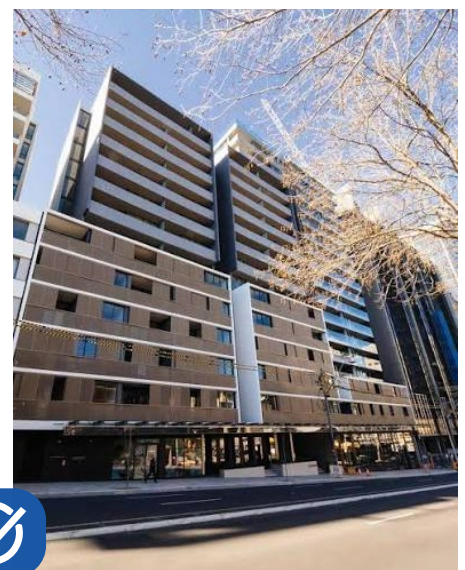
