Victorian Health Building Authority | Kingston, VIC | \$134.6m

The Kingston Residential Aged Care Development (KRACD) was delivered as part of the Victorian Government's 2020 State Budget to support the modernisation of Melbourne's public aged care sector. The project involved construction of a 150-bed, resident-centred facility designed for operational efficiency. Johnstaff provided project management and superintendent services from feasibility design through to post-occupancy evaluation. Our Health Advisory team also supported the principal design consultant, delivering planning services and contributing to the development of new models of care.

Cohuna Residential Aged Care Development

Victorian Health Building Authority | Cohuna, VIC | \$41.1m

Johnstaff provided full project management and health advisory services for the masterplan, feasibility and schematic design phases of the Cohuna Residential Aged Care Development. Our Health Advisory team supported the principal design consultant with planning services and the development of new models of care. Located on the Cohuna District Hospital campus, the facility delivers 16 single aged care bedrooms with private ensuites, natural light and open views, along with an additional 8 acute beds to support clinical needs. The purpose-built design accommodates a range of complex care requirements, including dementia and mobility support.

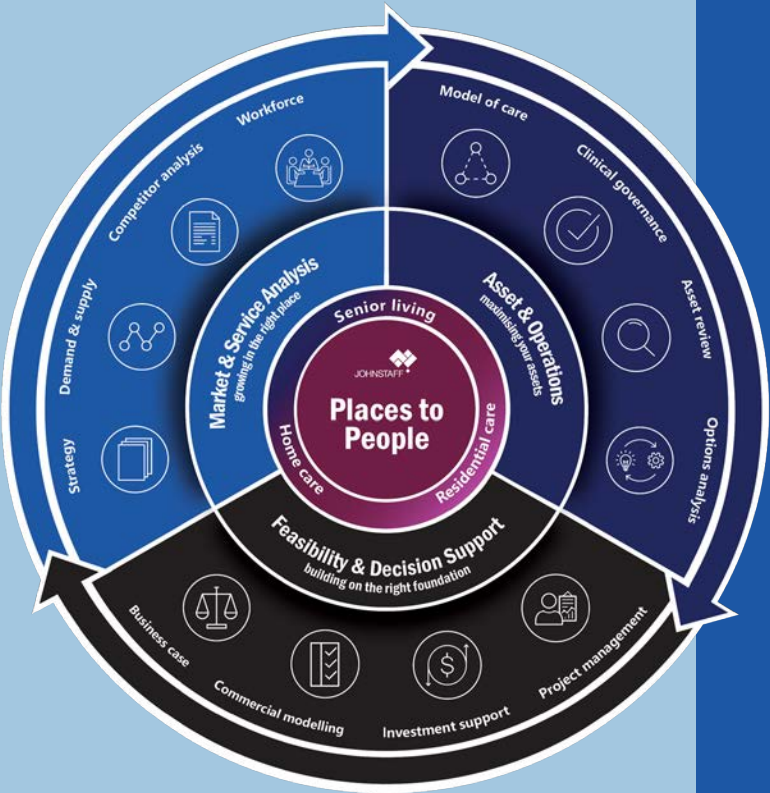
The new dementia-friendly Rutherglen Residential Aged Care Development has replaced the end-of-life Glenview Centre, delivering 50 public residential aged care beds with capacity to expand by a further 10 beds. The development includes integrated allied health and community services, with facilities for GP, physiotherapy, podiatry and other programs. Johnstaff provided project management and superintendent services from feasibility design through to practical completion and handover. Our Health Advisory team also partnered with the principal design consultant to support planning and develop new models of care.

The project involved the development of a new private hospital and a new, collocated 80 bed aged care residence. Both projects provide invaluable health services to cater for the increasing demand in the western suburbs.

Johnstaff was engaged as Project Manager for all phases of the project and Superintendent for the construction contract. Johnstaff worked closely with St Vincent's to develop a bespoke two stage procurement strategy and modified Design and Construct contract to reflect the desired risk profile of St Vincent's Health Australia.

Peninsula Grange Aged Care Facility (No. 2) has 127 beds and associated Wellbeing Centre. The site is located directly across the road from Australian Unity's Peninsula Grange which has a 102 bed RACF and 181 Independent Living Apartments.

Johnstaff was appointed to manage the EOI and Contractor Tendering for the new RACF No.2, including post tender negotiations, normalisation and recommendation to appoint. The Superintendent role was awarded to the Principle Consultant for administering the AS 4300 - 1995 contract as amended by the Principal.

Johnstaff provided full Project Management services for the redevelopment project, including demolition of existing dwellings and construction of 103 aged care accommodation beds. As part of the staging strategy Johnstaff's Construction Services team was engaged for an Early Works package to de-risk the site and provide additional time to finalise the main works design.

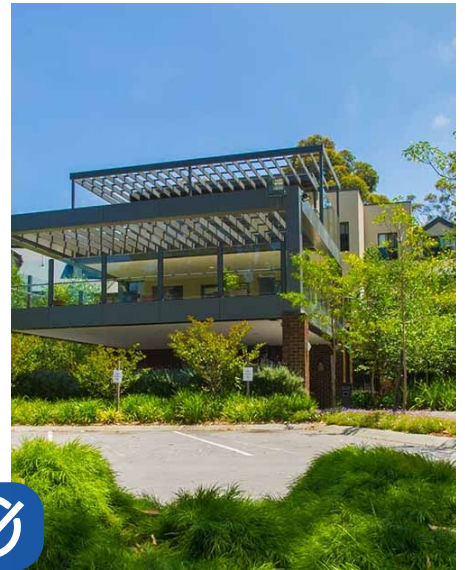

Our role encompassed a strategic review of the site, the development of a Master Plan and Feasibility Study and then through the various design and delivery phases to Construction, Commissioning and Handover.



End-to-end leadership delivering 90-bed aged care facility

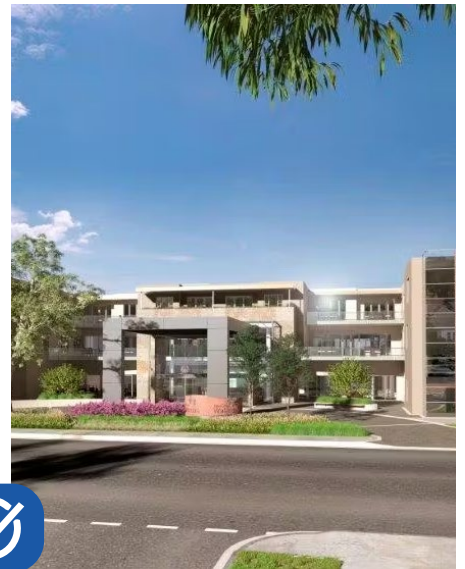


Waterdale Road Aged Care Facility

BlueCross Community and Residential Services | Ivanhoe, VIC | \$56m

Johnstaff was appointed as Project Manager for the tender negotiation and construction phases of the Waterdale Road Aged Care Facility.

The project saw the demolition of the existing aged care facility and construction of a new 178-bed 5-star residential aged care facility. The facility is designed to allow flexibility for further room conversions to residential suites as needed for the surrounding community.

Jewish Care | Windsor, VIC | \$85m

Johnstaff, as Project Manager, led the first stage of the redevelopment of Jewish Care's existing Windsor aged care facility. Stage 1 comprised a new eight level, 156 bed aged care building including healthy living facilities, ground floor retail and community spaces, staff support areas and basement carpark. All rooms were designed for ageing in place, with bonds reflective of location and level of finishes. Our role included the development of a site master plan and a detailed development staging and decanting strategy.

Opal Treeby Residential Aged Care Facility

Opal | Treeby, WA

Johnstaff provided project management and superintendent services for the delivery of Opal's 120-bed Treeby aged care facility, including resident amenities, staff facilities, commercial services and a wellness centre. The team also managed the procurement and coordination of all project consultants and specialists.

To maximise value and quality outcomes, Johnstaff led extensive value management and master planning reviews, assessing design, construction and operational efficiencies across the 10,000sqm site. This ensured the project achieved strong commercial outcomes while meeting Opal's operational requirements.

As part of the delivery, Johnstaff coordinated the project's mandatory public art component, integrating artwork into the building design, and successfully managed a post-contract variation to introduce three tensile shade structures without impacting the programme.

Despite significant challenges, including COVID-19 disruptions, project team changes and a key subcontractor insolvency, Johnstaff maintained project momentum and achieved unanimous Development Approval. The facility was completed only one month behind schedule and has since been recognised by Opal as one of its most successful developments for quality, bed yield and value for money.

The Falls Estate

Henroth | Frenchs Forest, NSW | \$43m

The Falls Estate is a gated community of premium, 41 two-and three-bedrooms Independent Living Units (ILU's) with associated underground parking and communal facilities on a 3.4 hectares site located in Frenchs Forest. The scope includes extensive civil reconfiguration works and construction of nine detached Class 2 buildings that are tiered to align with the topography.

Each of the retirement residences is ultra private, spacious, most with a northerly aspect and all with luxury fittings and finishes and sitting within landscaped grounds. Communal facilities include a swimming pool, gym and games area.

Johnstaff was engaged to manage procurement and act as Superintendent, but a gap between initial estimates and market pricing required extensive value engineering and redesign with the consultant team and contractors, including a planning modification. A separate civil early works contractor was procured to maintain progress, and the main works adopted a hybrid delivery model with a Guaranteed Maximum Price.

This approach enabled Johnstaff to appoint a high-quality contractor, maintain programme and design intent, and bring costs to an acceptable level.

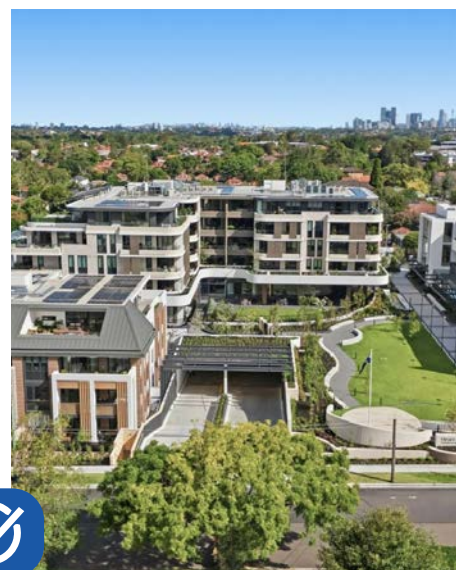

Heart of Willoughby

Hyecorp | Willoughby, NSW | \$300m

Heart of Willoughby is a luxury retirement living precinct comprising 126 apartments, dining, function and community spaces designed to foster connection, wellbeing and an enhanced lifestyle experience. Johnstaff provided Project Director services, leading the development of construction staging strategies and supporting project planning activities throughout the pre-delivery phase. The project required a carefully considered approach to maintain operation of the existing club while enabling future redevelopment of the site. Our team managed budgets, consultant engagement, specialist scopes, tender evaluations and feasibility investigations, helping establish a clear and achievable pathway for delivery.

Bulli Hospital and Aged Care Centre

Health Infrastructure | Bulli, NSW | \$54m

Johnstaff was engaged as Project Manager for the planning and delivery of a new integrated health and aged care facility on the existing Bulli Hospital campus. The development includes a multi-storey health care centre, 60 public aged care beds, 60 private residential aged care suites and an urgent care centre. The centre also comprises a range of clinical support services including outpatient and allied health services. The project is being delivered in partnership by Health Infrastructure (NSW Government) and IRT Group, one of Australia's largest community-owned seniors' lifestyle and care providers.

Sienna Grange Residential Aged Care Facility (RACF)

Australian Unity | Port Macquarie, NSW | \$18m

To expand the range of services for aging in place at the Sienna Grange Retirement Village by developing a new Residential Aged Care Facility, supplementing the independent living units on site. Johnstaff was engaged to provide Project Management and Contract Superintendent services for the project, commencing at the Contract Documentation phase, followed by tendering and administration of the Design and Construct Contract. Development of the site required the strategic management of approvals from a number of local stakeholder Authorities. Johnstaff coordinated all of the various inputs and consult work to obtain all of the necessary approvals.

Blue Care Community Care Centres

Blue Care | Multiple locations, QLD | \$15m

Johnstaff led the delivery of four new community care centres in South East Queensland. The new facilities at Coomera, Gatton and Goondiwindi were developed on greenfield sites, whilst the Toowoomba development comprised a combination of a new build and refurbishment. Each facility caters for 20-30 persons visiting daily to receive respite care, independence training and allied health services. These services are intended to support Blue Care's strategy of ensuring the elderly can remain in their own homes longer, and complement their existing residential aged care facilities.
