Parklea Correctional Centre Expansion, Department of Justice NSW | \$200m, Parklea, NSW

Johnstaff provided Project Management services for all phases of the delivery of an expansion of the Parklea Correctional Centre. The project increased the capacity of the existing centre by adding 150 minimum and 500 maximum security beds. The expansion was part of NSW's Prison Bed Capacity Program with the objective of providing additional prison beds across NSW to manage the prisoner population and to reduce safety risks for prisoners and staff at each of the correctional facilities. The facility was built in a complex environment, within and around the operating Parklea Correctional Centre.



Enhance Support Unit Youth Justice Strategic Business Case, Youth Justice NSW | \$25m, Sydney, NSW

Johnstaff's advisory team was engaged by Youth Justice NSW to develop an Infrastructure NSW compliant Strategic Business Case (SBC) to outline the case for capital investment in enhanced support for high-risk custodial youth. Leading a multi-disciplinary consultant team, Johnstaff delivered a robust SBC which assessed a range of options for implementation of interventions related to high-risk youth in custody. The SBC recommended investment in purpose-built Enhanced Support Units to separate high-risk individuals with complex needs from the general population and enable specialised care.



Eastern Goldfields Regional Prison, Department of Treasury | \$232m, WA

The Eastern Goldfields Regional Prison (EGRP) is a new 350 bed multi-security level and mixed gender prison built adjacent to an existing prison site in Boulder in regional WA and delivered through a PPP delivery model. Johnstaff was appointed by the WA State Government as Project Manager to support the State's EGRP Project Team. Johnstaff worked within the State's office and alongside the State's Representative during the delivery phase to ensure alignment of the works with the project objectives and applicable Government guidelines and to keep the State fully informed of all project issues.



Hopkins Correctional Centre Expansion, Ageis | \$551m, Ballarat, VIC

The Hopkins Correctional Centre Expansion Project delivered facilities for an additional 358 prisoners and was constructed around the existing operational prison in Ararat, in regional Victoria. Johnstaff was engaged by the PPP financiers following the collapse of the previous builder to form part of the project reimplementation team. Johnstaff led the new procurement strategy which included an early contractor involvement phase while previous works were audited and subcontractor settlements finalised. Our team provided Project Management and Superintendent services.



Parklea Correctional Centre Expansion, NSW



Heidelberg Magistrates' Court Redevelopment, Court Services Victoria | \$5.4m, Heidelberg, VIC

Following a significant flooding event Johnstaff was appointed as both Project Manager and Construction Manager to complete the rectification and refurbishment of the Heidelberg Magistrates' Court. Due to the significant pressure on the remaining State Magistrates' Court system, an accelerated briefing, design and construction process was adopted which included Johnstaff engaging all design consultants and trade contractors directly to enable an immediate start to works on site.



Family Violence Initiatives and Safe and Secure Courts Asset Upgrade Project, Court Services Victoria | \$25m, VIC

Johnstaff was engaged as Program, Project and Construction Manager to complete an audit of 40 courts throughout Victoria and to develop a program and priority of works in order to accommodate additional court staff, provide safe waiting areas and address recommendations emanating out of the Royal Commission into Family Violence. Our team subsequently project managed upgrade works across 27 sites as well as construction management services for a series of urgent upgrade works at a further 7 sites. All upgrade works were staged to avoid disrupting ongoing court services.



Prison Asset Data Collection, Department of Justice and Community Safety | VIC

Johnstaff provided Advisory and Project Management services to identify and record over 400,000 assets across 12 Victorian public prisons. This project required engagement of an extensive sub-consultant team. Johnstaff provided the Department of Justice & Regulation with a single point of contact and ensured that the deliverables were consistent, accurate and vetted prior to any release. Through our previous prison and site audit experience, the Johnstaff team provided a number of recommendations on additional asset data to be collected in order to increase the benefits of the project.



Asset Maintenance Delivery, Department of Justice and Community Safety | VIC

Johnstaff led the development of a central outsourced asset maintenance procurement model for all of Victoria's public prisons and a number of ancillary buildings. Providing Advisory services, our team engaged a multi-disciplinary group of specialists to provide the necessary technical, legal and financial services. Johnstaff provided recommendations on the contract model, performance regime and risk profile. In addition our team provided business case advisory services in order to justify the need for change and additional funding.
