Tonight, we gather to honor the remarkable achievements of past PIL athletes, coaches, and administrators, and to celebrate the rich history and proud tradition of this great league.



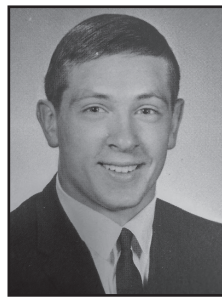

PIL Athletic Director of the Year 3 times; Oregon Boys Basketball Coach of the Year in 2020 by National Federation of High Schools. All-time Boys' Basketball wins leader at Franklin HS (106) and Wilson HS (245); 18 playoff appearances; Robert Blanchard PIL Distinguished Service Award 2013-2014. Also coached football, volleyball, tennis, golf, and baseball.

Love served tirelessly for 11 of the 30 years of Inductions, serving as President from 2004-2014. He was a star Baseball Pitcher at both Cleveland High School and Portland State University. He won 5 conference titles as PSU's Baseball Coach from 1962-74 and served as Athletic Director for the Vikings from 1971-1986. He was a member of the Hall of Fame at Cleveland, the PIL, PSU and the Oregon Sports Hall of Fame.



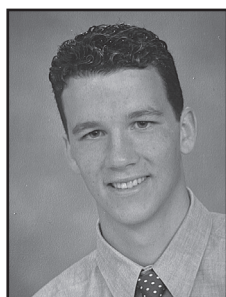
Bill & Katey Taylor
