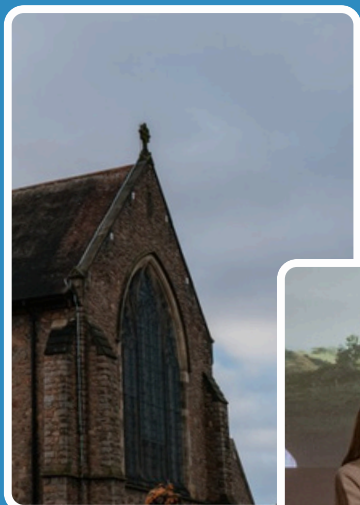

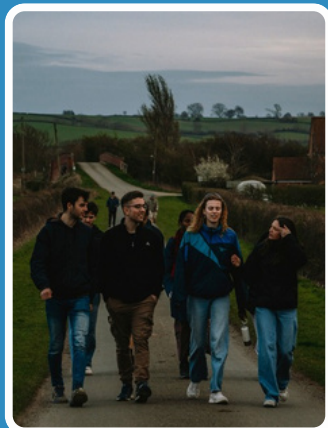

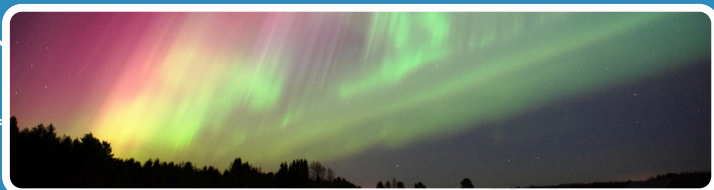

DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY

This Discovery Bible Study is for those who are curious about faith and would like to find out what the Bible says about the big questions of life eg. Is God real? Why am I here? What's the best way to live a good life?

10 passages to look at:

1. The beginning - Genesis 1:1 - 2:24 (God created the world and humanity)
2. Free will and the fall - Genesis 3: 1-24 (The first sin and its consequences)
3. Sins spreads - Genesis 6:1 - 9:17 (The flood and first covenant)
4. A way to live right - Exodus 20:1-21 (The 10 Commandments)
5. A remedy for sin - Leviticus 4:1-35 (The sacrificial system)
6. The Lord who sees, knows & provides - Psalm 23:1-6, Psalm 139:13-16 (The Lord who knitted me together is my shepherd)
7. The rescue plan - Luke 1:26-38, Luke 2:1-20 (The birth of Jesus)
8. The Father's heart - Luke 15:11-32 (The parable of the lost son)
9. The ultimate remedy for sin - Luke 23:32 - Luke 24:35 (The death and resurrection of Jesus)
10. A response is needed - Romans 3:23, John 3:1-21 (A gift and a choice)

Start by reading the passage together (out loud can be helpful)

Then one of you retell what you have heard in your own words

How do these passages challenge you to live differently?

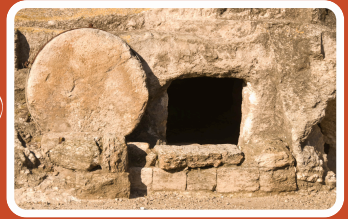

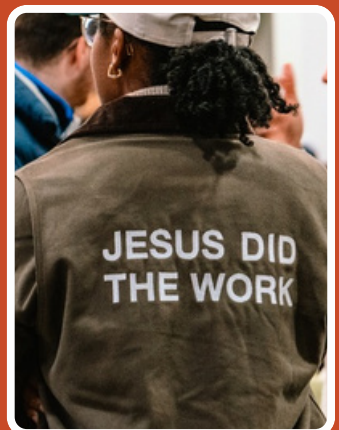

DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY

This Discovery Bible Study is for those who are curious about Jesus and are being drawn to understand more about him, his teaching and the impact he has on people. It contains seven conversations between Jesus and spiritually hungry people and three inspiring stories.

10 passages to look at:

1. Party at Levi's - Mark 2:1-17
2. Jesus Teaches Nicodemus - John 3:1-17
3. A Transformed Life - Mark 5:1-20
4. A Memorable Act - Luke 7:37-50
5. The Lost Son Returns - Luke 15:11-32
6. Thank You - Luke 17:11-19
7. What God Sees - Luke 18:9-14
8. Coming to Your House - Luke 19:1-10
9. Hungry for God - John 4
10. Hearing God - Mark 4:1-20

DISCOVERY BIBLE STUDY

This Discovery Bible Study is for those who have recently decided to follow Jesus. The passages outline what it means to be a christian and lay all the important foundations of following Jesus as friend, Saviour and Lord.

10 passages to look at:

1. Following Jesus - Luke 5:1-10 (Jesus calls Peter & John)
2. Repent & believe - Luke 19:1-10 (Zacchaeus) / Luke 7:36-50 (The sinful woman)
3. Hear and obey - Luke 6:46-49 (Wise and foolish builder)
4. Be Baptised - Acts 8:26-39 (Ethiopian Eunuch)
5. Pray - Matthew 6:5-15 (Jesus teaches about prayer)
6. Go...make disciples - John 4:4-42 (The Samaritan Woman)
7. Love - Luke 10:25-37 (The Good Samaritan)
8. Worship through perseverance - Acts 16:25-34 (The Philippian Jailer)
9. The Lord's Supper - Luke 22:7-20 (Jesus' Last Supper)
10. Gather - Acts 2:36-47 (The First Church)
