



# STEPS TO INSTALL

Install Minecraft Bedrock via Microsoft Store

- Open the Microsoft Store app on your PC.
- Search for "Minecraft Launcher" and install it.
- Sign in with a Microsoft account—this should be the one you used to purchase Minecraft or will use to buy it.
- Open the Minecraft Launcher after installing.
- In the launcher, select "Minecraft for Windows" or "Bedrock Edition" from the menu.
- Download the custom world file (e.g., from a museum or educational website) if provided as a .mcworld file.
- Click on "Install" to download Minecraft Bedrock Edition on your PC.
- Once installed, select "Play" to start the game.

# INSTALL ON WINDOWS

After purchasing, install the game properly to ensure all files are added and linked to your account.


## Using the Microsoft Store:

Go to Library > Minecraft > Install in the Store.

Wait for the progress bar to finish and confirm that the Install button changes to Play.

## Using the Xbox App or Launcher:

From the Xbox app, click Manage install to pick a location. If you're using the Minecraft Launcher, ensure both Bedrock and Java show up under your profile—this confirms the unified version is installed correctly.



# SIGN IN

Once installed, on the homepage, choose **Sign in** or **Create Account** in the launcher if this is your first time.

Make sure it matches the account used to buy the game.

Finally, enable access for cross-play and cloud saves.

You can also check Windows privacy settings if multiplayer or marketplace options appear disabled.

Launch and verify the edition Make sure you're running the Bedrock Edition, not Java. The launcher shows both options side-by-side under one account.

Press the Windows key and select

**Play > Minecraft for Windows.**

The Bedrock version will open with the modern interface and marketplace tab.

You can now confirm the cross-platform friends list and the in-game store.

If you see these, you're in Bedrock Edition.



# HOW TO PLAY

## Welcome to Uppåkra

When you open the game it will guide you through the first quest that serves as a tutorial.

## General gameplay

1. Talk to the scientists and archaeologists
2. Excavate objects
3. Travel back in time and complete the quest
4. Report your findings
5. Learn more about the history and science involved

# HOW TO PLAY

## There are 7 quests in total

- The lost tooth mystery (part of the mandatory tutorial)
- The necklace in the marsh
- Trading at Uppåkra
- Murder Mystery
- The holy grails of Uppåkra
- Train to go on a Viking raid
- Tear down the Cult house and build a church

In addition to these seven missions, you can also compete to recreate Uppåkra's Great Hall in Minecraft.

More information about the finds and results from the excavation will be added here on Uppåkra's website as it progresses.

During or after completing all the quests you can join in reconstructing the Great Hall using the same facts as the archaeologists.

We will add more information about the finds and results from the excavation as they happen on the website. In this quest you will handle a variety of sources and suggest the one you think is the most credible way to reconstruct the hall.

# PRO TIPS

## **Get Bedrock free if you own Java Edition:**

If you previously bought Java Edition, you get Bedrock for free under the same account.

To check the entitlement, open the Minecraft Launcher and verify that both Java Edition and Bedrock Edition appear on the left side of the Play screen.

**Redeem if missing:** If Bedrock does not show up on your account despite purchasing Java, open the Microsoft Store's account page and select Redeem Code or Gift Card to activate it manually.

**Optimize performance and gameplay:** Update drivers and Windows, and adjust in-game settings



# NOTES

- No academic Microsoft account is needed for Bedrock—just a regular personal account.
- This guide covers only the installation and launch of custom Bedrock worlds.
