You are required to make an appointment for a Wellness Check-up and establish your new cat(s) as a patient within 30 days. When you visit your vet ALWAYS bring a poop sample. It is natural for kitties to obtain worms from nursing. Now that your cat(s) do not share a litter box with multiple cats, you can make sure worms are gone and will never return.
