





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- UDL is about best teaching practices for the inclusive classroom
- Assistive technology enables greater individualization, which can help a child with disabilities to function in an inclusive classroom
- Technology can make it easier for a teacher to implement universal design

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Accommodations and the Law





Section 504 (1973): Prohibits exclusion of individuals with disabilities in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance.

Section 508: Prohibits federal agencies from procuring, developing, maintaining, or using electronic and information technology that is inaccessible to people with disabilities.

Americans with Disabilities Act (1990)

Prohibits discrimination of the basis of disability.



Individuals with Disabilities Education Act of 1997

Ensures a free appropriate public education to all children with disabilities.




Specific Learning Disabilities

Disorder in one or more of the basic psychological processes involved in understanding or using spoken or written language resulting from an imperfect ability to:








To make a podcast you need to record to an audio file. Use freeware like Audacity. Then all you need is a podcast host (like PodBean) and an RSS feed.
