

- The Parent Infant Program at Kingsford Elementary is closing at the end of the 2022-2023 school year. The program will be relocated to Doswell Brooks Elementary School.



Updates on Special Education Program Location Changes

- The Social Emotional Academic Development (SEAD)
 Program at North Forrestville is closing at the end of the 2022-2023 school year. The SEAD program will be relocated to Francis Scott Key Elementary beginning in SY 2023-2024.
- The middle school students in grades 6-8 from James E.
 Duckworth Regional Program will be relocated to Sonya
 Sotomayer Middle School beginning in SY 2023-2024.
- A new special education early childhood program will open at Cora Rice Elementary School beginning in SY 2023-2024.
