School Calendar Adjustment Update

On March 24, the Maryland State Board of Education approved a waiver that allows Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS) to implement updates to the 2025–26 school calendar to make up lost instructional time. The Board will take final action on March 26.

Key Updates

- **Last day of school:** Thursday, June 18
- **Full school days:** March 27, April 22 and June 18 will now be full days (no early release).
- **The instructional school day will start 5 minutes earlier** in schools from April 7 through June 18.

Make-Up Days

- May 27
- June 15
- June 16
- June 17
