- 2.5. The Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who breaches these Terms and Conditions or engages in any unlawful, improper or fraudulent conduct in connection with the Competition.
- 2.6. The Promoter is not responsible for any technical issues or access failures relating to Ticketmaster Australia, internet connectivity or telecommunications networks.
- 2.7. If an entrant receives a refund for their Event ticket prior to the draw, their entry will be deemed invalid. If the Event is cancelled or rescheduled for any reason, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel, suspend or modify the Competition, subject to any applicable laws.
