LEEDS ASSOCIATES TRAINING PROGRAMME 2026/27

Our Associates Training Programme offers **ballet** and **contemporary** dance training for students **aged 7-18yrs**, who are seeking additional training to complement their training at their local dance school. This programme focuses on enhancing ballet and contemporary technique, whilst also providing an environment for students to develop their musicality, artistic performance levels and confidence during repertoire and creative classes.

Throughout the course, students will work with a diverse variety of teachers and choreographers from leading dance institutions. Students receive 2 hours of tuition each week (2.5 hours for Advanced Group). Each session follows a structured yet varied curriculum designed to challenge and motivate students as they progress - training includes a balance of technical ballet classes, contemporary dance, and creative repertoire work.

- **Weekly associate-style training:** with exposure to multiple teaching styles of ballet & contemporary in a supportive, structured environment.
- **Develop and progress your technique:** with regular training that complements your local dance training you will improve posture, strength, balance and musicality that will enhance all areas of your dance journey
- **Train with industry professionals:** work with teachers and choreographers who are currently or have previously worked with leading dance companies and schools
- **Grow your artistry and confidence:** express your artistry with the opportunity to perform in the end-of-year showcase
- **Build friendships and teamwork:** work in a supportive and like-minded group of passionate dancers and make friends that will last a lifetime

Will there be a performance?

At the end of the programme, students will have the opportunity to demonstrate some of their learnings in a small and intimate showcase, where students will perform ballet and contemporary repertoire. Each student will receive 2x complimentary tickets to the showcase, and 1x complimentary ticket will be offered to each student's local dance teacher too.

COURSE STRUCTURE

Sessions 1-12: Students will focus on technical development in both ballet and contemporary classes.

Sessions 13-18: Using their learnings from their technique classes, students will be taught and rehearse repertoire which they will perform in the end of year showcase.
