

AO26 Live Site – Conditions of Entry

By participating in the AO26 Live Site (“the Event”), you agree to comply with the conditions of entry imposed by any ticketing service acting for or on behalf of South Bank Corporation (“SBC”), together with the following conditions:

1. The “Event Area” is the area designated by SBC and delineated by fencing for the purpose of the conduct of the Event.
2. No person will be served alcohol without appropriate ID to verify age.
3. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for ensuring children do not disrupt the enjoyment of others, and in the event of any unacceptable disruption, both parents and children may be asked to leave the Event Area.
4. No pushing, shoving, or rough physical contact with other participants will be tolerated at any time.
5. Any participant found engaging in harassment, disrespectful, or disruptive behaviour will be asked to leave the Event.
6. All event staff will be identifiable by uniform and/or appropriate badges, and all instructions from event staff must be followed.
7. No animals are permitted within the Event Area, other than certified assistance animals.
8. SBC reserves the right to modify, postpone, or cancel the sessions due to unforeseen circumstances.
9. All participants consent to bag checks as a condition of entry to the Event Area.
10. No inflatable or collapsible chairs, stools or other furniture may be taken into the Event Area.
11. Toilet and other facilities will be available outside of the Event Area. Re-entry to the Event Area is permitted.
12. Water filling stations will be available at various points throughout the Event Area.
13. No professional photography is permitted.
14. Please note that CCTV cameras are in operation throughout the South Bank Parklands. Additionally, still photography or video footage may be taken of the Event for SBC’s marketing purposes. If you wish not to be photographed for that purpose, please communicate that fact to a staff member.
15. The following are prohibited to be brought into the Event Area:
 - a. Weapons and blades
 - b. Alcohol and any illegal or prohibited substances
 - c. Hazardous or flammable substances including aerosol cans
 - d. Liquid in unsealed bottles (empty bottles are permitted)
 - e. Glass or metal including containers and cans

- f. Marquees, tents, shade structures,
- g. Helium balloons, laser pointers and confetti cannons
- h. Large poles, banner stands or flags
- i. Drones or remote-controlled devices
- j. Professional cameras and recording devices (not phones)
- k. Umbrellas
- l. Any item or object deemed to:
 - i. Compromise public safety
 - ii. Harm the reputation or enjoyment of the event
- m. No recreation bikes, scooters or rideables.
