

Cotton Flatweave (Dhurrie) cleaning instructions

Cleaning a cotton dhurrie rug requires a gentle approach to maintain its quality and appearance. Here are steps to clean it effectively:

1. **Vacuuming**: Regularly vacuum your dhurrie to remove dirt and dust. Use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to avoid damaging the fibres.
