

# Guardianship & Boarding House Requirements

Some XCL World Academy (XWA) students study in Singapore while their parents are overseas. To help our students integrate well into school life and succeed academically, XWA requires all overseas students to stay with an appointed guardian or at a boarding house. This not only satisfies the XWA's guardianship and boarding house requirements but also keeps international students safe while they are not in school and are unaccompanied.



## Family's Appointed Guardians

Guardianship provides an additional level of support and care for international students whilst they are residing in Singapore. The students benefit from being supported by a trusted adult who will take care of their wellbeing away from home and who can be there in an emergency situation on behalf of their parents.

As the person with shared delegated parental responsibility, the role of the guardian is to be the primary caregiver for the student(s) while they are living in Singapore. Guardians who are formally entrusted with the care of a child are expected to act in loco parentis.

To ensure that each child's welfare and well-being is given the highest priority, it is important that there is an effective 3-way partnership between the **school** (teachers and the pastoral care team), **parents**, and the appointed **guardians**.

Parents can choose to appoint a family friend, a relative or a professional guardianship agency. We highly recommend performing extensive research and engaging only trustworthy individuals or accredited organisations to ensure high-level support and care for your child.

#### **XWA Guardianship Policy**

XWA has established guardianship terms and conditions to:

- Provide parents and formally appointed guardians with a clear explanation of the school's expectations relating to 'in loco parentis' guardianship.
- Provide parents with a clear explanation of the responsibilities of the guardian they appoint for their child.
- Notify parents that the school reserves the right to determine the acceptability of arrangements made for their child(ren) in Singapore. Should the arrangements be considered to be unacceptable, parents and guardians will be advised and a reasonable opportunity to change the arrangements will be provided.
- Provide guidance to parents on how communications between the school, international parents, and guardians will operate.
