Dr. Vasiliki (Ilia) Roussou is Assistant Professor of Prosthodontics at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, with more than 25 years of academic, clinical, and scientific activity in prosthodontics, occlusion, temporomandibular disorders, implant prosthodontics, and orofacial pain. Her private practice is limited to Prosthodontics and Orofacial Pain.

Her academic background includes D.D.S., M.S., and Ph.D. degrees, advanced postgraduate training in Prosthodontics at Temple University School of Dentistry in Philadelphia, USA, and further training in Orofacial Pain at the University of Kentucky, USA. From 1997 to 2009, she held clinical and teaching appointments in undergraduate and postgraduate prosthodontics at the Dental School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and served as full-time Assistant Professor in Prosthodontics from 2009 to 2023.

Her teaching and clinical focus have included fixed and removable prosthodontics, occlusion in prosthodontics, full-arch rehabilitation, digital prosthodontics, and the diagnosis and management of temporomandibular disorders and orofacial pain.

Dr. Roussou has been invited to lecture and present at national and international scientific congresses, dental societies, and postgraduate academic programs in Greece and abroad. Her scientific work and publications have focused on temporomandibular disorders, bruxism, occlusion, implant restorations, digital prosthodontics, prosthetic complications, and esthetic rehabilitation. Her professional service has included leadership roles in the Greek Prosthodontic Society, the Athens Dental Society, the American Dental Society of Europe, and the International College of Dentists.
