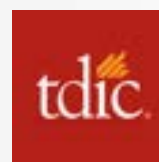

Dr. Bellamy was born in Queens, New York. As the child of a career Air Force Professional, he has lived all over the world including New York, Texas, Europe and California.

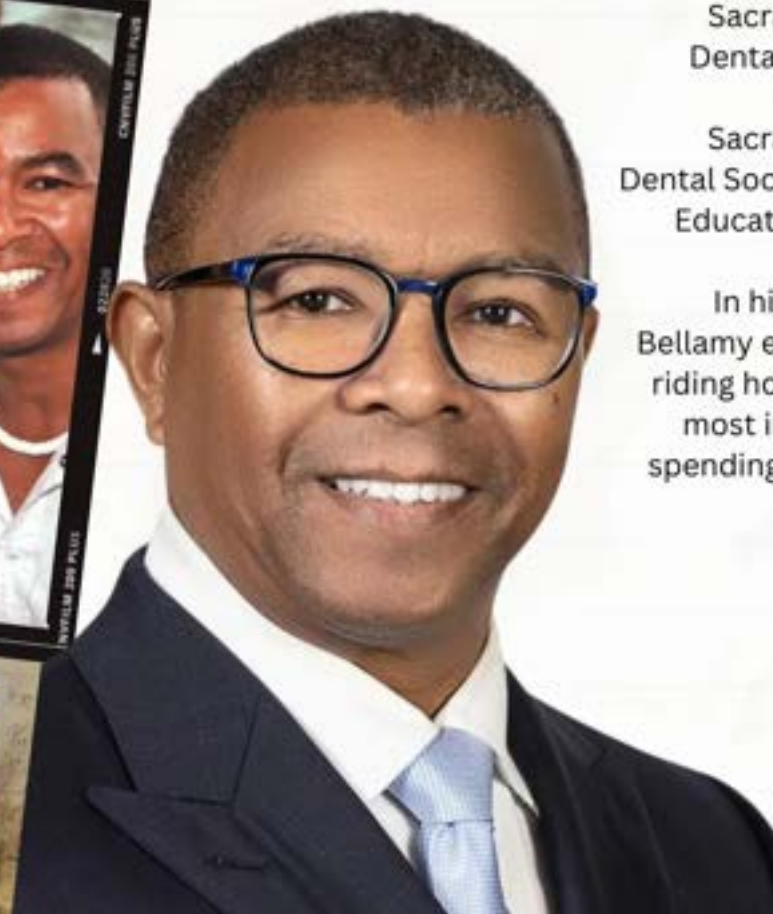

ABOUT THE **SSNDA**

The Sacramento Society of the National Dental Association (SSNDA) has served the Greater Sacramento Area since 1983. The SSNDA developed as a branch of the statewide California National Dental Association which was started with the aid of several pioneering Sacramento dentists, Dr. Eugene Spencer Jr., DDS, Dr. George Stewart, DDS, Dr. James Martin, DDS, and Dr. Kenneth Ponder, DDS. Dr. Eugene Spencer would serve as an early president of the California NDA and help establish the SSNDA. Dr. Spencer also played a key role in other important organizations such as the Sacramento Urban League and Sacramento National Pan-Hellenic Council. His mentor was Dr. Roscoe Brewer, the first African American dentist in Sacramento, CA. Dr. George Stewart was the second Black dentists to practice in Sacramento. He served his country during WWII and was a trustee at Los Rios Community College for 16 years. Dr. Morris was the third Black dentist in Sacramento.

Dr. Ronald T. Blanchette, DDS served as the first president of the local NDA chapter. The SSNDA has provided dental education and resources to the community. Our activities include providing dental screenings at local churches in Del Paso Heights and Oak Park and providing dental supplies at the Annual Sacramento Black Expo. The SSNDA combined efforts with the Capital Medical Society to host Golf Tournaments for the purpose of providing scholarships for future healthcare professionals. The SSNDA helped support several students at Sacramento State create an undergraduate chapter of the SNDA in 2006. A group of 12 dentists has become a larger network of dental professionals who support each other, students, and the community.

Congratulations to our member, Dr. Wallace Bellamy on becoming the 102nd National Dental Association President!

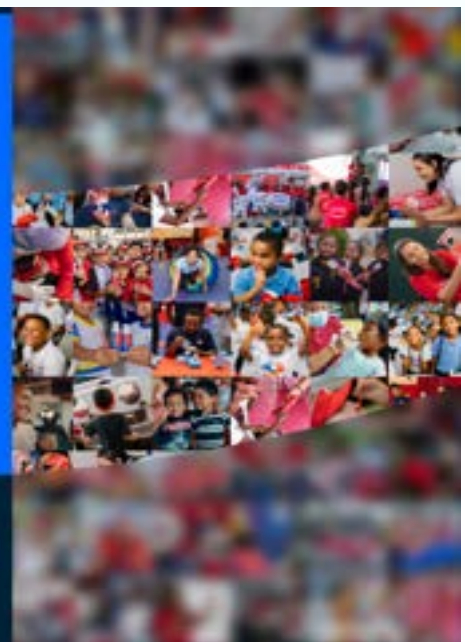
