HSE Single-user sink - construction, event and off-grid hand-washing

A single sink with a wide and deep bowl to comply with the UK Health & Safety Executive construction site requirements for users to be able to wash the full forearm. This sink is typically used inside plastic, mains-free portable toilets but may also be used elsewhere as an extra hand washing solution.

Hygienic, foot- operated pump minimises hand contact. The sink pedestal acts as the fresh water reservoir for 45 litres of water: grey, "soapy" water in the bowl runs away via the waste pipe to the portable toilet tank or a separate container / drain.

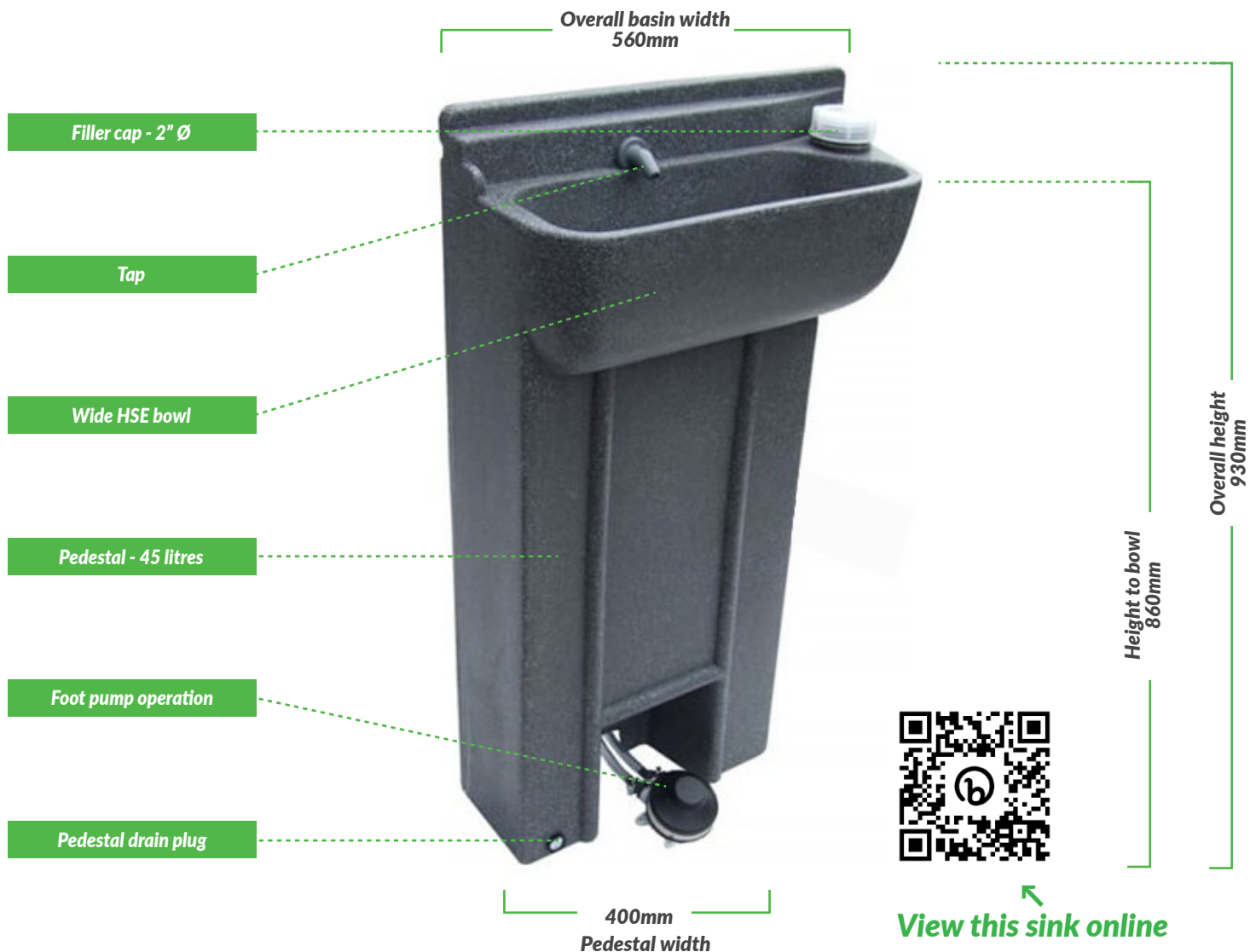

How does it work?

This sink is typically installed on the left-hand side of the toilet unit (on entry) and the extended width bowl - a Health & Safety construction site requirement to allow users to wash their hands and full forearms - will overhang the toilet tank by a few centimetres.

The sink pedestal acts as the fresh water chamber, is filled via a 2" screwed cap to the right of the tap and can be drained via a drain plug at the base.

- Press the foot-operated pump to dispense fresh water into the sink bowl
- Soapy "grey" water drains from the sink bowl via a 3/4" hose to the toilet tank
- The sink is typically cleaned and replenished with fresh water during the standard cleaning schedule arranged with a serviced portable toilet rental company
