This award celebrates teachers who spark curiosity, creativity, and cultural understanding through inspired instruction.

Eligibility

All educators teaching Chinese in Southern California are welcome to apply, including those in world language programs, immersion programs, weekend schools, and online classes.

Evaluation Criteria

All submissions will be anonymously reviewed by a committee selected by CLTA-SC. Entries will be evaluated based on the following criteria (see here).

Award Details

• Eight Awards in total: Four Outstanding Awards & Four Innovation Awards. Each recipient will receive \$300 in recognition of their outstanding contributions.

- All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation and a collection of all lesson plans during the Spring Pedagogical Conference of CLTA-SC.
- Award recipients are encouraged to present their work at an online and/or in-person workshop on April 25, 2026.
- The recipients' work will also be featured on the China Institute and CLTA-SC websites.
