Understanding the DDA Collection

| LC. PLAT 2+ | Open Platform Lift (AS 1735.15) | 400 kg | Up to 2 m | Ideal for retail, education, and health environments needing compliant access. |
| LC. PLAT E4+ | Enclosed Vertical Platform Lift (AS 1735.15) | 400 kg | Up to 4 m | Provides enclosed travel for indoor or semi-exposed sites requiring DDA access. |
| LC. PLAT E1K+ | Enclosed Vertical Platform Lift (AS 1735.15) | 1,000 kg | Up to 4 m | Heavy-duty commercial access for higher loading requirements. |

| Question | Why It Matters |
|--|---|
| Required floor-to-floor travel? | Determines suitable model and required capabilities. |
| Installation location (internal/external)? | Influences material selection and finishes. |
| Who will be using the lift? | Ensures correct platform sizing and operational features. |
| New build or retrofit? | Impacts access, delivery method, and installation timeline. |
| Expected duty level? | Helps determine which model is best suited. |
| Access for installation? | Determines feasibility for commercial sites. |
| Compliance requirements? | Ensures the correct AS 1735 standard is applied. |

Stairway platform lifts for straight or curved stairway applications.
