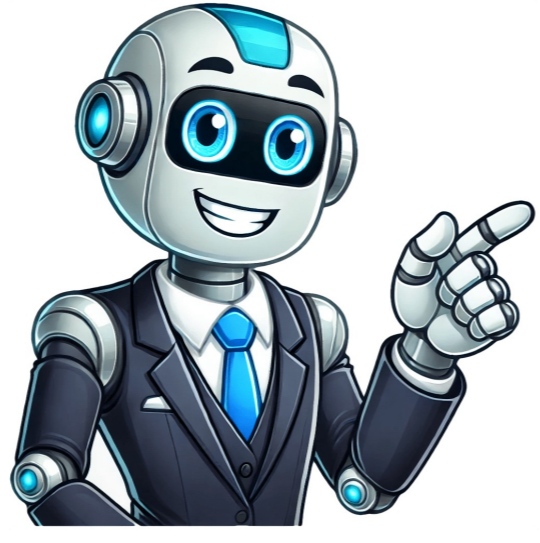

Users can save any video on Facebook to watch later or download it using third-party apps like Friendly Social Browser, a versatile option for both Android and iPhone users. The process of saving a video within Facebook is similar to bookmarking; here's how: 1. Locate the desired video. 2. Click or tap the more icon in the top right corner of the video post. 3. Select Save video from the dropdown menu. Saved videos can be accessed later by clicking on Watch and then Saved Videos on computers or tapping Saved in the mobile app on phones. In a new tab, paste this link into the box on fdown.net and click Download to begin the process. Alternatively, if you want to bypass third-party services, try the desktop trick using the .mbasic version of Facebook. Visit the video's link in your browser, replace "www" with "mbasic," then hit enter. You'll access a mobile-optimized site with the desired video at the top; simply click play and save it as you would normally. For Android users, downloading videos is relatively straightforward. Open the Facebook app, find the target video, tap Share, select Copy link, and paste this into your browser. If prompted to open the Facebook app again, close it and try long-pressing on the video instead, then choose Download video from the pop-up menu. If these steps don't work for you, consider using a third-party service like fdown.net. It offers a user-friendly interface but may limit the video quality. We've tested it successfully with Google, Vivo, and Xiaomi handsets running Google Chrome. To start, you can visit the results page directly or access it via the provided link. Most video downloaders function similarly to this app, requiring only a few steps to download a video from Facebook: 1. Open Facebook through your mobile browser or app. 2. Capture the video's URL by tapping the Share icon and selecting "More Options" > "Copy". 3. Access the video downloader app and paste the copied link into the clipboard. Some notable features of this chosen app include its automatic recognition of Facebook video URLs and offering options for downloading videos in high definition (HD) or standard definition (SD), along with saving the file to your gallery. A year ago, users could right-click a video and capture its URL, but this feature has been modified. Today, two methods are provided for downloading Facebook videos: using a web browser or Chrome browser extensions, as detailed in articles linked at the bottom of the main text. Individuals can download almost any non-advertised, publicly available video from Facebook by following these steps: (1) copy the video's URL, either through the "Copy Link" option on mobile devices or by highlighting and copying the top-level browser URL on computers; (2) paste the URL into a specific web-based application, such as FDownloader, which supports various platforms including computers, Android, iPhone, and iPad; (3) use the selected app to download the video. To start downloading a Facebook video using FDownloader, begin by clicking on the download button. Then, you'll be presented with available video quality options. Choose the preferred quality and click or tap 'Download' next to it. This initiates the download process. Once complete, the downloaded file can be found in your default 'Downloads' folder, identified by its '.mp4' extension. If you opt for a significantly lower or higher quality than the original video, FDownloader will prompt you to render the video first before downloading. Rendering requires some extra time as it performs additional tasks in the background. For mobile users on an iPhone or iPad, after completing the download, navigate to your 'Downloads' folder and double-click (or tap) the video to play it. To transfer the video into the Photos app, access the address bar with a blue arrow icon, select 'Downloads,' then click the desired video. Tap the share icon and choose 'Save Video' from the list. To download a Facebook video manually using your web browser: 1. Go to the relevant Facebook video on the platform. 2. Copy the video link by clicking the share button beneath regular posts or by playing reels and selecting 'Copy Link'. 3. Open a new tab in your web browser and paste the link into the address bar. Change 'www' to 'mbasic' in the URL, which will transform the interface into a simplified version of Facebook. 4. Click or tap the video to play it in full-screen mode. 5. To download the video, right-click (or control-click on Mac) on the video playback and select the appropriate option from the context menu, such as 'Download video' or 'Save video as.' Mobile users can tap and hold the video then choose their preferred action. For downloading your own uploaded videos directly from your Facebook profile: 1. Access your profile page by logging into Facebook.com. 2. Click on your profile icon in the top-right corner, followed by selecting your name at the top of the drop-down menu. 3. Navigate to the 'Video' tab located at the top of the page to view all uploaded videos. 4. Select the desired video and click the icon with three dots (⋮) next to your username. 5. Choose 'Download video' from the options provided, which will save the file in your default 'Downloads' folder. That way, you can easily share it without having to scroll through your newsfeed. Here's how to download a video from Facebook on your Windows or Mac computer or an iPhone or Android device. You can download a video from Facebook as long as it has been set to public. Tap three-dot icon on Facebook video, Copy Link, and replace www with mbasic in browser. Long-tap video, select Download video, and open Facebook app. Sign in if needed. Find desired video, tap three-dot icon, and Copy Link. Paste link into browser address bar, replace www with mbasic, and hit Go. Tap video again, long-tap to select Download video. Allow Chrome access, and once download finishes, click Open. View downloaded video by going to Files app on home screen. To download Facebook video on iPhone, tap Share, Copy Link, and use MyMedia app to go to fdown.net, paste link, and tap Download the file.
