Hunter Biden leaked photos

Right-wing nonprofit Marco Polo has published nearly 9,000 photos from Hunter Biden's laptop online. The pictures include intimate moments with prostitutes and drugs use by Hunter as well as family snaps and everyday shots. Among the 8,864 images are 7,032 from Hunter's MacBook Pro, 1,832 from his iPhone XS backup, 428 short videos (live photos), 674 text messages, 579 screenshots, 40 WhatsApp pics, and 111 other images. Some have geographic coordinates showing locations worldwide, including Hawaii, Cabo San Lucas, Kosovo, the Dominican Republic, China, London, Paris, Rome, Belgrade, and across the US. The pictures were taken between 2008 and 2019 and match a copy of Hunter's laptop obtained by DailyMail.com in early 2021. Marco Polo redacted explicit content to protect privacy, including account numbers, credit card info, and social security numbers. The nonprofit claims it aims to expose corruption and blackmail, releasing all images to give the public an accurate picture of the Biden family. The trove uploaded last week by his organization contains 98% of the photos from the device after removing some images like screenshots of Candy Crush games. Ziegler has also published a 645-page report on Marco Polo's investigation into Hunter Biden's laptop. The report accuses Hunter of 459 crimes including prostitution offenses, distribution and possession of drugs, defrauding government agencies, illegal foreign lobbying and money laundering. It also claims that President Joe Biden was complicit in tax evasion, violated the Presidential Records Act, and used nonpublic information for financial gain. Ziegler has published over 120,000 emails from the laptop on his website, as well as transcribing and publishing pages from Hunter's sister Ashley Biden's diary. Hunter Biden's team called the lawsuit against Marco Polo "utterly ridiculous" and "false." Ziegler, who has been hired by Lunden Roberts' lawyer to analyze Hunter's laptop, has also been linked to a court case over child support for their daughter Navy Joan. The hiring is seen as a blow to Hunter's legal team, which argued that Ziegler lacks experience as an accountant or finance expert and poses a security risk. Hunter's financial records have been made public after being recovered from his abandoned laptop, including photos of his family members and personal activities. His lawyer Abbe Lowell has asked Congress to investigate how Marco Polo obtained Treasury Department Suspicious Activity Reports (SARs), which are part of the evidence used by Republican lawmakers in their probes into alleged corruption within the Biden family. Ziegler is accused of using Hunter's SARs to create a false narrative about him being associated with a human trafficking ring. Some SARs detail money flowing to accounts linked to Hunter and other Biden family members, while others show payments made to suspected prostitutes and pimps. Hunter Biden, son of US President Joe Biden, is facing a federal gun trial over allegations he lied about his drug use when buying a gun in 2018. The case centers around messages found on a discarded laptop that suggested the possibility of a hot tub party with multiple women waiting for him. Hunter has a history of substance abuse and has been to rehab. He recently admitted to cleaning up his act, but the leaked photos from his laptop continue to haunt him. A recent poll found that half of Americans believe he received preferential treatment from prosecutors, who allowed him to plead guilty to tax charges while avoiding a gun-related conviction. The FBI found no evidence of wrongdoing by President Joe Biden regarding a laptop containing emails and photos that suggested his involvement in a Ukrainian energy company, Burisma, and alleged use of drugs. The laptop was brought to Mac Isaac's store in April 2019, and its contents were later published by the New York Post and local police. The story claimed that Joe Biden intervened in Ukraine to help his son Hunter, who worked for Burisma, but it has been largely debunked. Hunter Biden has sued several people involved in the publication of the laptop's contents, including Giuliani and Costello. In 2023, Biden filed an ethics complaint against Rep. Marjorie Taylor Greene for displaying sexually explicit photos of him during a House Oversight hearing. The White House has denied investigations into President Biden's corruption as partisan efforts.
