Carpools receive preferential parking in parking lots 1, 3, and 4. * A current Butte College carpool decal is required for carpooling, and registration with the Butte College Facilities Department is necessary. ****Electric Vehicles and Alternative Fuel Vehicles**** Preferential parking for electric vehicles and alternative fuel vehicles are available on the main campus. Our institution provides equal access to its programs and facilities for all students. The bus transportation system accommodates both non-disabled and disabled passengers on a space-available basis. All currently enrolled students are eligible to use this service. If you have concerns about sexual harassment, you can file a formal complaint with our Title IX Coordinator. You can do so in person, by mail, or via email. The coordinator will explain the college's disciplinary process and discuss available supportive measures. You have the right to have an advisor of your choice present during this meeting. Throughout the grievance process, both parties (complainant and respondent) have the right to an advisor of their choice. If a party does not have an advisor at the time of the hearing, the district will provide one free of charge. Your professors may be notified about your complaint if you request interim academic measures during the resolution process. The Title IX Coordinator will discuss this with you before initiating contact with your professor. In 2020, changes to the Title IX regulations introduced a formal hearing as part of the resolution process. Although elements of these regulations have been challenged in court, a formal hearing remains a requirement. Our Title IX Coordinator can provide updates on any legal changes that may impact this requirement. You have the right to appeal the decision if you are unhappy with the outcome. According to AP 3434, a complainant or respondent must submit a written appeal within 5 business days from the date of the notice of determination regarding responsibility or dismissal of a formal complaint. Grounds for Appeal in a Title IX Complaint The District's Title IX Coordinator will appoint a Decision-Maker to review an appeal of the District's determination regarding responsibility or dismissal of a formal complaint. To file an appeal, the Party must specify the grounds for appeal and provide supporting facts. The eligible grounds include: Procedural irregularity that affected the outcome - New evidence not available at the time of the decision that could impact the outcome - Bias or conflict of interest among the Decision-Maker or Investigator affecting the outcome To be eligible for our programs, you must meet at least one of the following conditions: * You are a first-generation student and do not have a parent with a four-year college degree. * Your family has limited income, and your taxable income meets federal requirements. * You have a documented physical or learning disability and can provide proof. * You are a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen.
