















Equity over everything.

Black-identifying founders that come to DMZ receive additional opportunities and specialized support like grant funding, mentorship opportunities, a peer network, exclusive events and connections to investors dedicated to supporting Black-led innovation – on top of the standard programming all DMZ founders get.

DMZ's Women Innovation Programs provide a full spectrum of startup support to women founders at every stage of the entrepreneurial journey, from the ideation phase to the scaling phase. Women-identifying founders that come to DMZ receive additional opportunities and specialized support to accelerate their growth, like exclusive community events, mentorship opportunities, a peer network and connections to investors dedicated to supporting women-led innovation – on top of the standard programming all DMZ founders get.

Committed to leveling the playing field for all entrepreneurs, Abdullah has championed several initiatives for underserved founders designed to meet them where they are. Through DMZ's Black Innovation Programs, Women Innovation Programs and catered streams for Indigenous founders, DMZ offers curated support, ensuring everyone has a fair shot at success.

Under Abdullah's leadership, the global startup ecosystem has significantly expanded its impact by establishing global hubs across North America, Latin America, Africa, and Asia; broadening its support to serve upskilling professionals in tech and business foundations; and launching DMZ Ventures' investment fund for pre-seed and seed-stage tech startups.

Beyond his work at DMZ, Abdullah serves on the Board of Directors for the Rideau Hall Foundation, the Power Plant Contemporary Art Gallery, and the Indigenous Prosperity Foundation. Frequently asked questions and misconceptions.

What does DMZ stand for?

DMZ is no longer an acronym for Digital Media Zone. It's simply referred to as 'DMZ'

Is DMZ just for students?

DMZ is not just for students. In fact, the median age for an entrepreneur is 34 years old.

Is DMZ an Incubator or Accelerator?

DMZ is a tech incubator. It has implemented a model that fuels a startup pipeline which includes:

- Launchpad For aspiring entrepreneurs who want to build a business and need support getting started.
- Pre-Incubator For founders who have an early prototype and are ready to validate their business idea, establish an MVP, and ramp up for launch.
- Incubator For pre-seed and seed-stage startups that have a full-time founder, early traction, and proven product-market fit.

Does DMZ take equity from startups?

Startups do not pay membership fees for the Pre-incubator or Incubator. Instead, DMZ takes a 2.0% equity stake in common shares from Pre-incubator startups and a 2.5% stake from Incubator startups, in exchange for programming. Any and all returns on this equity go back to Toronto Metropolitan University, a charitable organization, to support future DMZ operations for startups. DMZ looks for exceptional founders to support on their journey to build, grow, and scale high-calibre tech companies. Having an equity stake in companies further reinforces DMZ's commitment to helping founders see long-term success.

Does DMZ focus on a specific tech vertical?

No, DMZ is sector-agnostic, though we have a preference towards B2B or B2B2C business models.
